



As summer winds down and a new school year has begun, we all can see, the first three of the major projects of our Capital Campaign are complete- the Parking Lot, Rectory, and Soccer Field have been beautifully constructed and are in full use.

We are so grateful for what God is doing in our church! Already, the new facilities are being used every week by children, students, families, and ministries of all kinds. Lives are being touched, relationships are being formed, and the gospel is reaching further because of the space we now share together.

We launched our Capital Campaign so that *every family* could be part of building this legacy. So far, about 1,000 families have stepped forward — but our dream is 100% participation. Why? Because this isn't just about paying for buildings and a field—it's about every single one of us having the joy of saying, *'I was part of what God built here.'*

Today our Capital Campaign has an approximately \$600,000 shortfall. If only 400 families of the 4,000 who have not joined us, can commit to just \$10 per week, we can make up that difference between our costs and our donor pledges.

Every family still has the opportunity to be part of the legacy. We are asking you, every parish family, to join us, so that not just a few are carrying the load. Remember you can contribute with a weekly donation of only \$5 or \$10 dollars (or whatever schedule or amount your family can afford).
