Body Worn Camera evidence processed by the Discovery Department of the 4th Judicial District Attorney's Office is released to the attorney of record separately from discovery released through the state of Colorado eDiscovery system: Colorado District Attorney Council (CDAC).

Law enforcement agencies within the 4th Judicial District have opted to utilize **separate** systems to store their Body Worn Camera evidence.

The **AXON** system a/k/a <u>Evidence.com</u> is a body worn camera system utilized for the following law enforcement agencies in the 4th Judicial District: **Colorado Springs Police Department,** Colorado State Patrol, Fountain Police Department, Manitou Springs Police Department, Monument Police Department, Calhan Police Department, Green Mountain Falls, Woodland Park and Cripple Creek Police Departments, Law Enforcement of Pikes Peak State College, Law Enforcement of University of Colorado – Colorado Springs. Evidence from this system will be shared to the attorney of record through the AXON website. An email notification is sent to the attorney's email address stating body worn camera evidence has been shared. Within the email there is a link in which to access, view and download body worn camera evidence for the case.

The **Teller County Sheriff's Office (TCSO)** for body worn camera evidence uses the vendor **Polaris**. For information regarding body worn camera footage, the email address is: records@tellercounty.gov; phone number: (719) 304-5754. The TCSO website url for Polaris differs slightly from the Polaris website url for CSPD. This is important information to remember as you log into your established account(s) and review BWC shared evidence.

The **El Paso County Sheriff's Office (EPSO)** releases body worn camera evidence utilizing the **Motorola** system. The new Motorola BWC system for EPSO was implemented in 2024. Through the discovery process, the attorney of record is notified of EPSO body worn camera evidence via a link sent to the defense attorney's email address. The link within the email will transition users to the **Motorola Cloud Share** System and includes information to set up a Motorola Cloud Share account. Setting up the Motorola Cloud Share Account allows users to access, view and download shared body worn camera evidence. Colorado Springs Police Department BWC evidence recorded prior to December 2024, was stored in the Polaris system. As of June 2025, prior CSPD BWC that was stored in the agency's former Polaris system will be available through Axon.

El Paso County Sheriff's Office BWC evidence <u>recorded</u> prior to January 2024, was stored in the Availweb system. As of April, 2024, <u>prior EPSO BWC that was stored in the agency's former Availweb system will be provided on an external media device.</u>

<u>The 4th Judicial District Attorney's Office shares evidence from each of these</u> <u>systems with the attorney of record only.</u> Questions concerning body worn camera evidence may be directed to the Deputy District Attorney within the division or the Discovery Department Staff.
