Rendon Dietzmann arrested in Texas, extradition process underway

COLORADO SPRINGS, COLO. – On September 28, 2023, Rendon Dietzmann allegedly traveled on Interstate 25 from Colorado Springs to the Denver metro area in 20 minutes at speeds of over 150 miles per hour.

Colorado State Patrol conducted an investigation, with assistance from the Dallas Police Department, identified Dietzmann as the motorcyclist involved, and issued a warrant for his arrest on suspicion of the following crimes:

- Menacing, C.R.S. 18-3-206, Misdemeanor 1
- Engaged in Speed Contest, C.R.S. 42-4-1105(1), Traffic 1
- Reckless Endangerment, C.R.S. 18-3-208, Misdemeanor 2
- Reckless Driving, C.R.S. 42-4-1401, Traffic 2
- Speeding 40/More over limit, C.R.S. 42-4-1101(1), Traffic 2
- Engaged in Exhibition of Speed, C.R.S. 42-4-1105(2), Traffic 2
- Vehicle had no Number Plates Attached, C.R.S. 42-3-202(1)(a), Traffic Class B

On February 7, 2024, Dietzmann was arrested in Denton County, Texas on CSP's extraditable warrant. The process to bring Dietzmann back to El Paso County, Colorado is now underway.

Dietzmann's first court appearance in El Paso County will be scheduled following the completion of the extradition process.

Criminal charges are merely allegations and all persons charged with committing a criminal act are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt, and the same holds true for Rendon Dietzmann.
