MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 3

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Jefferson County Emergency Services District No. 3 ("District") was called for at 4:00 p.m. on May 12, 2025, at the District's administrative office, located at 3554 S. Pine Island Rd., Beaumont, Texas 77713, pursuant to notice duly posted according to law.

At approximately 4:00 p.m., the regular meeting was called to order. The roll was called of the duly constituted officers and members of the Board, to wit:

Assistant Treasurer

All of said Board members were present (Secretary Courville arrived after the meeting had stared), thus constituting a quorum. Also present at the meeting were: Daniel Diaz, District Administrator; Mary Ellen Robertson, the District's accountant; Joshua Heinz of Benckenstein & Oxford, L.L.P., attorneys for the District; Cody Abshire with Heat Safety; Jefferson County Commissioner Brandon Willis; and, various members of the fire department.

Upon establishing that a quorum was present, President Saunders asked for public comment as set forth in Agenda Item No. 3, at which time Cody Abshire advised the Board that his company, Heat Safety, provides SCBA flow testing services.

Then, under Agenda Item No. 4, Mr. Diaz reviewed with the Board his written monthly Administrator Report and Chief Kibodeaux's Chief Report, copies of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

The Board then moved along to Agenda Item No. 5 for review of the minutes of the regular meeting held on April 14, 2025. Upon motion by Assistant Treasurer Phelps and seconded by Vice President Rose, and with the unanimous consent of the Board members present, the Minutes were approved.

Next, the Board was directed to Agenda Item No. 6 for review of the financial statements and payment of the District's bills. Mr. Diaz and Ms. Robertson reviewed and discussed with the Board the monthly financial statements and listing of bills being presented for approval and payment, copies of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. Mr. Diaz also recommended that \$20,000 be transferred from the District's savings account (Stellar account ending 7793) to the checking account (Stellar account ending 9872). Upon motion by Vice President Rose and seconded by Assistant Treasurer Phelps, and with the unanimous consent of all the members present, the Board approved payment of the bills reflected in the check list and checking account register (Check Nos. 4949 and 5016-5034), and the Entergy, Mastercard Card Services, and other autodebit/ACH payments), and the \$20,000 fund transfer from the District savings account to the checking account.

Thereafter, the Board was directed to Agenda Item No. 7, at which time Mr. Diaz advised that the District is expected to receive a \$5,000 health & wellness reimbursement grant from Texas Mutual, which the department plans to use on the purchase of a new treadmill and rowing machine for the fire station (total cost: \$4,989.99). Upon motion by Vice President Rose and seconded by Treasurer Douget, the Board unanimously approved and authorized the exercise equipment purchase subject to confirmation that the District has been approved to receive the grant.

The Board then moved along to Agenda Item No. 8, at which time Mr. Diaz reviewed and discussed with the Board the finance options received from Government Capital for the new Engine 31 purchase (expected delivery in late June). The matter was tabled so that Mr. Diaz can verify the rates and confirm any prepayment penalties.

President Saunders then directed the Board to Agenda Item No. 9, at which time Mr. Diaz reviewed with the Board the following items which are recommended to be declared as salvage/surplus property and disposed of: (1) FireIce Brush Skid Unit, Serial No. 154004 ("skid unit"); (2) Bauer SCBA fill station/compressor, Model No. K14BPHB1, Serial No. 32620 ("fill station"); and, (3) Chevrolet pickup truck, Model No. C2500, VIN: 1GCHC43K29F113585 ("truck"). Vice President Rose made a motion to declare and authorize the following: (1) skid unit – surplus property, to be donated to Angelina River Authority VFD through Helping Hands program; (2) fill station – salvage property, donated to/for Helping Hands program; and, (3) truck – surplus property, to be sold through Horn Auction. The motion was seconded by Secretary Courville and approved by a 4 in favor/1 against vote of the Board members.

Being as there were no other matters to come before the Board under Agenda Item No. 10, the regular meeting was adjourned at approximately 4:45 p.m.

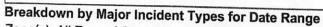

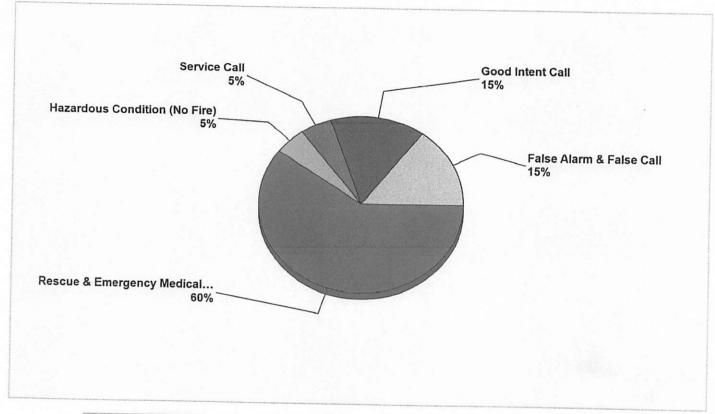

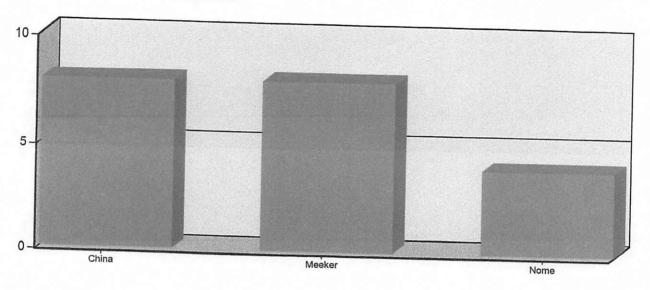
