

Camp Meeting Information & Policies 2024

If you have questions that are not answered in the camp meeting booklet or through this policy sheet, please check with guest services. Their phone is (509) 242-0663. The hours are 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. during the week of camp meeting.

Parking:

If you are camping, or in a trailer or 5th wheel on the ballfield, **please do not plan to drive on and off the ballfield during camp meeting.** If you need to use your vehicle during camp meeting you must park in a designated parking lot. In the event of rain, grassy parking areas will be closed.

RV and Tent Sites:

All tent camp sites come without hookups. If for medical reasons you must have power, please look into a battery option as we cannot make power available. There are limited RV electrical and water hookup options available for an additional cost.

Ballfield Sites:

All sites located on the ballfield must be reserved and occupied from Wednesday through Sunday morning. Due to pedestrian safety, setup and take-down cannot take place Thursday through Saturday.

Shuttle Service:

Volunteers at camp meeting drive shuttle golf carts to assist those with special needs. Please look on your map for shuttle stops and make full use of this service. We hope your travel around campus will be safe.

Sewer and Water:

A holding tank pump-out service will be available for \$45 on Friday only. There is not a potable water delivery option available this year. You **must** sign up at guest services on Wednesday or Thursday and follow the directions given to receive the pump-out service.

Meals:

The Upper Columbia Academy cafeteria will provide meals throughout camp meeting. All Sabbath meals must be purchased in advance.

Restroom/Shower:

Restrooms and portable toilets will be available throughout the campus. Showers in the gym are available from 5 a.m. to 11 p.m.

Pets:

NO pets are allowed on campus, in meetings, tents or dorm rooms, except trained service animals. Guests in RVs may bring a pet as long as they comply with the above statement and clean up completely after their pet. Any pet owner out of compliance with this policy will be asked to leave immediately.

Sabbath:

Please honor the Sabbath by not moving in or out during Sabbath hours, sundown Friday through sundown Sabbath.

Curfew:

In consideration of others, please keep the grounds quiet from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Prohibited:

Alcoholic beverages, smoking, illegal drugs, firearms and fireworks are not permitted on campus. Hoverboards, skateboards, scooters and roller blades are not permitted during camp meeting. Bicycles are allowed only on roads and will be confiscated by security if used anywhere else.
