AHA successfully redeveloped the 11-acre, public housing site by deploying multiple funding mechanisms in three phases. The campus now provides 144 units of affordable housing for seniors and 50 units for families. The project was financed with a combination of Low-Income Housing Tax Credits as well as taxable and tax-exempt debt. The total cost was approximately \$51 million.

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
