Attire: Fun Formal (Semi-Formal to Formal)

Step into the Jazz Age at the newly renovated Indiana Roof Ballroom (1927 vibes)! Think glitz, glamour, the Charleston, and It's a Wonderful Life or a little bit o' Gatsby style. Our lively dances involve bouncing, twirling, bending, leaping, skipping, and kicking, so choose outfits that allow free movement. Dressing in theme is **fun, but optional**—be yourself, and keep it classy, not costum-ey.

Ladies

Wear:

- Semi-formal (knee-length) to formal (floor-length) gowns or dresses. To ensure a comfortable and elegant experience for all, we kindly ask that the length extend to past mid-thigh.
- Flapper-inspired dresses with fringe, sequins, or beads.
- Mary's prom from It's a Wonderful Life- inspired dress.
- Elegant accessories like headbands, pearls, or long gloves.
- Secure strapless or V-neck gowns (no lower than bra line). We suggest sewing panels in V-neck gowns.
- Non-see-through midriff coverage; two-piece dresses must overlap by 3 inches. No cut-outs below the waist.
- Dance-friendly shoes (low heels, Mary Janes, ballet slippers, or sparkly sneakers). If you wear high heels for the Red Carpet look, consider bringing a second pair to dance in.
- Bike shorts (4" inseam) under above-knee dresses (REQUIRED)

Not Allowed:

- Trains, slits above low-thigh, plunging necklines, or low-back cutouts.
- See-through mesh violating rules or short cocktail dresses. Clingy mermaid dresses are allowed, but NOT suggested. They will NOT be comfortable for dancing.
- Trousers/pantsuits (except formal sari with approval).
- Body piercings (except earrings or small nose stud).

Gentlemen

Wear:

- Suits, dress slacks with suspenders, bow ties, or vests. Jackets optional.
- Fedoras, flat caps, or slicked-back hair.
- Collared shirts and ties REQUIRED.
- Dress shoes, clean dress boots, or NEW, CLEAN tennis shoes.
- Formal military uniform, white dinner jacket, or dress kilt (with shorts).

Not Allowed:

- T-shirts, jeans, flip-flops, sandals, or dirty shoes.
- Costumes or skirts (except dress kilt, as mentioned above).
- Body piercings (except small stud earring).

Expectations

- **Wristbands:** Wear color-coded wristbands at all times. No wristband, no entry. Leaving unchaperoned means no re-entry.
- **Dancing:** No provocative moves, groping, or body-to-body dancing. Keep it wholesome, and allow room for the Holy Spirit.
- **Behavior:** Show respect, follow chaperone instructions, and avoid PDA beyond hand-holding. No bullying, foul language, food, drink, alcohol, smoking, or vaping.
