





included \$25.00 in cash, a handsome, twelve inch tall trophy and, of course, instant fame.

Since that time, they have played for community civic organizations, churches and many special events as well as a fer private parties. Their motto became "Will work For food", and for a

majority of the time, that was their only pay.

In mid-2003, the group invited a young violinist, Will Bush, to join the group. Will has much classical experience and training, having attended Baylor University, Waco, Texas, on a music scholarship, and at that time was playing with the Arkansas Symphony Orchestra. As a youngster, however, he had heard and learned many old-time fiddle tunes from his Grandfather. Will's agility and style has added very much to achieve the group's present sound.

The group's name came from a term applied to several old time cowboys who used to gather at a drugstore in Weatherford, Texas in the 1950's. They were considered to be a step above "Drug Store Cowboys, and were called "Rexall Rangers". Jack Thompson recalled the name and thought it might fit the group. They have been the "Rexall Rangers" for nearly ten years. God has blessed them spiritually, physically and musically, and no one enjoys the music of the Rexall Rangers anymore than they enjoy performing it.

The money raised by the auction is split between the growers and the Kiwanis Club. The club uses part of the money for summer youth sports, and the fourth of July fireworks show.





The annual 5K Strawberry Run attracts runners from many state as well as locals. There is a division for most any age runner who wants to compete including a fun run for those who don't compete.








