Southern Cream Strawberry Pie by Charla O'Neil

1 - 9" baked pie crust of own choice

Filling:

1 cup water

¼ cup strawberry jelly

½ of a 3 oz. package of strawberry gelatin

6oz cream cheese

1 Tbsp. Sugar

2 Tbsp. Orange juice

1 ½ quarts of fresh hulled whole strawberries (rinsed)

Heat water and jelly in a small, heavy saucepan over high heat until mixture comes to a boil and jelly is melted. Add gelatin and stir until dissolved. Chill in refrigerator until mixture mounds slightly when dropped from a spoon (about 1 ½ hours)

In a separate bowl beat cream cheese, add sugar and orange juice –beat until fluffy. Spread over bottom of cooled 9 inch pie crust.

Arrange berries pointed end up over cheese layer. Spoon thickened glaze over strawberries. Chill at least 8 hours. Top each serving with a dollop of homemade whipped cream, if desired.

Grandma Sharon's Strawberry Cream Cheese Pie by Jamie Marshall

1 lg can of strawberry pie filling

1 deep dish pie crust

8 oz. cream cheese

1 - 14 oz. can sweetened condensed milk

1/3 cup lemon juice

1 tsp. vanilla

Bake pie crust according to directions. Cool.

Beat together cream cheese, sweet milk, lemon juice and vanilla until creamy.

Layer half the strawberry pie filling on the bottom of the crust.

Pour the cream cheese mixture over the filling. Top with the remaining strawberry filling.

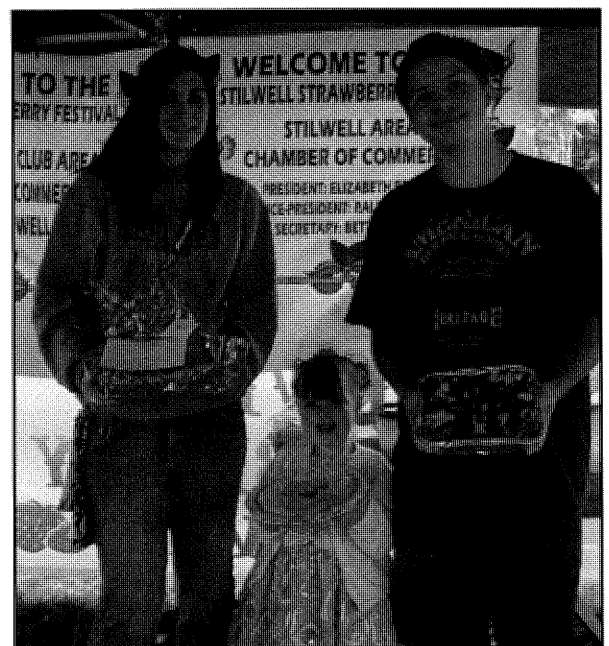

Reed's Hardware by Quentin M. and Gene Reed

In the early 1900s, J.R. Reed started a business located on the property where the Bank of Commerce is now located, selling according to the sign on the windows, "Dry Goods, Groceries, and Ladies' and Gents Shoes". Others in business with him were his son, Lowery M. Reed and his wife, Sarah, and B.F. (Fay) Reed and his wife, Lillus.

Mr. J.R. Reed was a successful and prosperous businessman and pioneer in the early days of Stilwell. He was president of the First National Bank of Stilwell, chartered in 1911.

About 1932 Lowery M. Reed, C.J. Carson and R.L. Reese bought the Rogers Hardware & Furniture Company from W.M. Rogers. It was located across the street from the J.R. Reed business. They renamed the store Reed - Carson Hardware & Furniture Company and sold groceries, furniture, and John Deere farm equipment. The John Deere farm equipment was shipped from St. Louis, and some were shipped in "pool cars" with Lewis Brothers in Fayetteville, Arkansas.

After Lowery's death in 1934 until 1946 Sarah Reed, C.J. Carson, and B.F. Reed were partners in the business. Slogans for the hardware store were "Buy your hardware from a Hardware Store - the House of Quality Merchandise for a Farm & Home" and "Quality remains long after the price is forgotten". Working in the business with Sarah Reed were B.F. and Lillus Reed, parents of Emma Dean Panter.

After returning from the service in 1946 Quentin M. and Welch E. (Gene) Reed bought C.J. Carson's part of the business. The name was changed to Reed's Hardware & Furniture Company with Sarah Reed Bragg and her two sons as partners. After Sarah's death, Quentin Reed, Jr. became a partner.

Today Reed's Hardware sells plumbing, electrical supplies, hardware, paint, and floor covering.

None of the success that Reed's Hardware has enjoyed in the past would have been possible without the help and support of B.F. Reed, Ross Reed, and Leonard Poor.

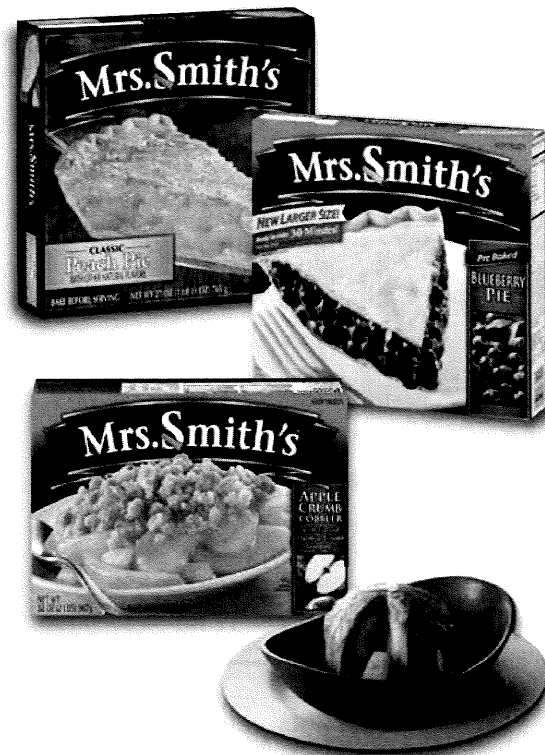

Susie McEntire's smile is a genuine one -- and a familiar one. With more than a passing physical resemblance to her sister, Reba McEntire, Susie also shares her big sister's musical giftings. But Susie has directed her talents to the country gospel side of American Roots music garnering much acclaim from her peers and fans alike. In addition to numerous awards and nominations from TNN, GMA, and CCMA, Susie has been named "Artist of the Year" several times in the field of Positive Country Music. She has also scored four #1 singles on the Positive Country radio charts. However, more than her notoriety, it is Susie's kindness and determination in the midst of difficulties and her authentic compassion for others that inspires people around her.

Susie often reflects about her early Christian experiences in her concerts, combining her wealth of songs (13 CDs to date) with inspiring life stories. In addition to performing concerts for sold-out crowds, they made television appearances on programs such as "The Johnny Carson Show," "Hee Haw," and "The Grand Ole Opry." Susie says, "I learned so much in this short period of time -- little did I know that this travel time with Reba would help to prepare me for my own solo career in music."

In 1984, Susie submitted to God's calling in her life to sing Christian music. AND she has been able to embark on a dream she's had for years: she is co-host of "Cowboy Church" on RFDtv. (Dish, Direct tv, and Comcast) "My family has been in the ranching/rodeo world for four generations, and I am so pleased to be able to bring Jesus Christ to this audience in a down to earth, country style."

Her latest release "Passages" marks a bold and honest stylistic growth reflective of her transformational life changes. Susie says "growing in faith means growing in all areas of my life, my country roots have grown into a full tree with a strong trunk and limbs. I can handle other styles that continue to celebrate the things country is known for. "Passages" is real stories about real people. I'm pretty sure that is what the spiritual life is about. I am so much more honest now at my core, living honestly in the faith of God. Cute play on words huh?"

A casual meeting in Oregon became a casual friendship for over a year. However, "Once we decided to lean into each other things went real fast" says her husband Mark from Seattle. So fast, they had a 5 day engagement and were married in Cannon Beach, Oregon in December 2009 joined by a close contingency of family and friends. Together Susie and Mark bring a partnership to their events. From a small intimate couple's, women's, or men's retreat to a full concert hall you will be encouraged and enriched by the program.

Susie continues to provide the same concerts we all know and love so well. With her husband or as a solo act, Susie McEntire just keeps getting better.
