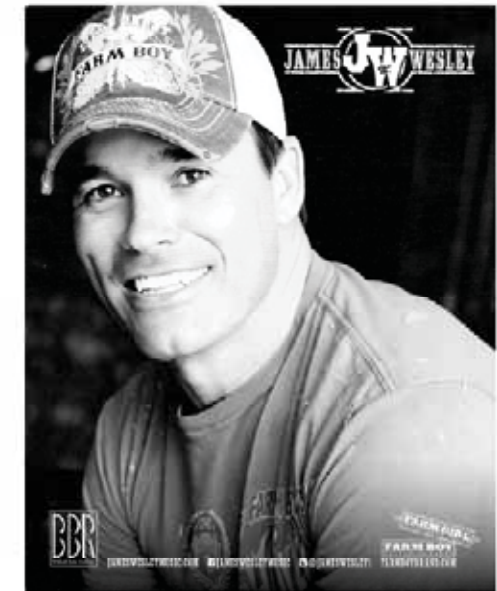

"I've always been a big believer in tradition," declares James Wesley. "A lot of the old ways are the best ways: family, God, treating people right, doing what you're supposed to do. I think it's time to come back to what's real. That's what country music is about."

James Wesley puts those core values into his music with a whiskey-smooth voice and a timelessly winning way with a great country song. Wesley sings directly to real people about real things that profoundly affect real lives – and from his small-town upbringing to his blue-collar work ethic, he has a deep understanding of what those folks are longing to hear.

Wesley grew up in tiny Mound Valley, a community of about 200 people in Southeastern Kansas. He first discovered country music via his grandmother's record collection, which included heaping helpings of classic crooners like Marty Robbins, George Jones and Ray Price. "We'd go over there on the weekends," he recalls. "She'd have the console set up and the records stacked up and we'd listen to them as they dropped. Those guys back then, they could sing. I thought, "That's what I want to do."

The breakout success of "Jackson Hole" instantly validated the enormous risk Wesley took in uprooting his family from Eureka Springs for an uncertain future in Nashville was worth it. "My family has seen all the ups and downs," he says. "There's been a lot of hard work. There's been times it wasn't easy, and they've been there the whole time. They're great." It also meant that Wesley's days of construction work were over. "Thank God I get to put the hammer down, at least for a while," he says with a laugh. "It's nice to be able to do what I love to do."

James Wesley hopes to do what he loves to do for a long time to come. "I want to be in it for the long haul," he says. "I want to do those songs that everybody wants to hear, and that everybody can feel. I want to be the guy who tells the stories, and tells it like it is."

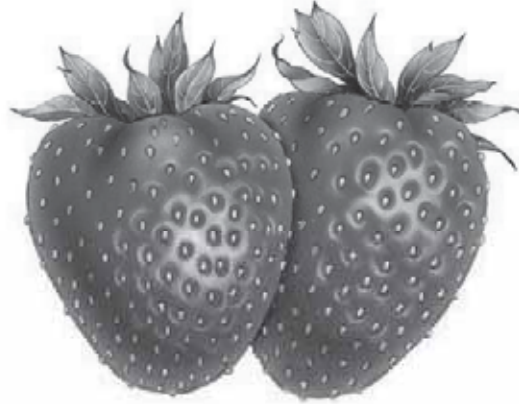

Reed's Hardware by Quentin M. and Gene Reed

Below (ca. 1910): J.R. Reed (on left) and Lowery M. Reed (on right), grandfather and father of Quentin M. and Welch E. (Gene) Reed.



In the early 1900s, J.R. Reed started a business located on the property where the Bank of Commerce is now located, selling according to the sign on the windows, "Dry Goods, Groceries, and Ladies' and Gents' Shoes". Others in business with him were his son, Lowery M. Reed and his wife, Sarah, and B.F. (Fay) Reed and his wife, Lillus.

Mr. J.R. Reed was a successful and prosperous businessman and pioneer in the early days of Stilwell. He was president of the First National Bank of Stilwell, chartered in 1911.

About 1932 Lowery M. Reed, C.J. Carson and R.L. Reese bought the Rogers Hardware & Furniture Company from W.M. Rogers. It was located across the street from the J.R. Reed business. They renamed the store Reed - Carson Hardware & Furniture Company and sold groceries, furniture, and John Deere farm equipment. The John Deere farm equipment was shipped from St. Louis, and some were shipped in "pool cars" with Lewis Brothers in Fayetteville, Arkansas.

After Lowery's death in 1934 until 1946 Sarah Reed, C.J. Carson, and B.F. Reed were partners in the business. Slogans for the hardware store were "Buy your hardware from a Hardware Store - the House of Quality Merchandise for a Farm & Home" and "Quality remains long after the price is forgotten". Working in the business with Sarah Reed were B.F. and Lillus Reed, parents of Emma Dean Panter.

After returning from the service in 1946 Quentin M. and Welch E. (Gene) Reed bought C.J. Carson's part of the business. The name was changed to Reed's Hardware & Furniture Company with Sarah Reed Bragg and her two sons as partners. After Sarah's death, Quentin Reed, Jr. became a partner.

Today Reed's Hardware sells plumbing, electrical supplies, hardware, paint, and floor covering.

None of the success that Reed's Hardware has enjoyed in the past would have been possible without the help and support of B.F. Reed, Ross Reed, and Leonard Poor.

The following have also worked for Reed's Hardware at different times: Carl Reed (B.F.'s brother), Naomi (Sis) Reed, Doris Jo Reed, Austin Johnson, Dollie Sharp, Pauline Ray, and Jack Eubanks.

Today Reed's Hardware is Owned by Quentin Reed, Jr.

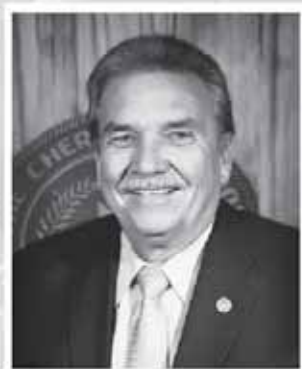

Fresh Strawberry Italian Cream Cake
Charla O'Neil -1st place Adult

Start a day ahead because curd must chill at least 8 hours.

Cake:

1/2 c butter softened
 1/2 c butter flavored Crisco
 2 c sugar
 5 large eggs - separated
 1 tblsp vanilla
 1 tsp baking soda
 2 c all purpose flour
 1 c buttermilk

Beat butter and Crisco at medium speed with an electric mixer until fluffy. Gradually add sugar, beating well, add egg yolks one at a time, beating well. Beat until well blended after each addition. Add vanilla, beat until blended. Combine flour and soda, add to sugar mixture alternating with buttermilk, beginning and ending with flour mixture. Beat at low speed until blended after each addition. Beat egg whites until stiff peak forms, fold into batter. Pour batter into 3 – greased 9" pans. Bake at 350 for 25 minutes until toothpick in center is clean. Cool in pan for 10 minutes then remove onto wire racks. Place cake on cake plate and spread 1/4 cup of strawberry curd on top. (the top layer will be very thick) Loosely cover cake and chill 8 hours. Spread 3 cups of icing on sides of cake arrange strawberries, pecans, whole strawberries on top for décor.

Fresh Strawberry Curd:

1 c sugar
 3 large eggs, beaten
 1/4 c cornstarch
 1/4 c butter
 1 tblsp zested strawberry
 2 c fresh strawberry juice

Combine sugar and cornstarch in 3 quart sauce pan gradually which in fresh strawberry juice. Whisk in lightly beaten eggs. Bring to a boil (5-6) minutes over medium heat, whisking constantly. Cook until pudding thickens. Remove from heat and whisk in butter and zested strawberry. Cover with plastic wrap and chill 8 hours.

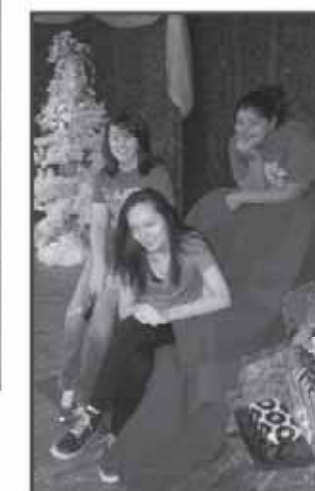

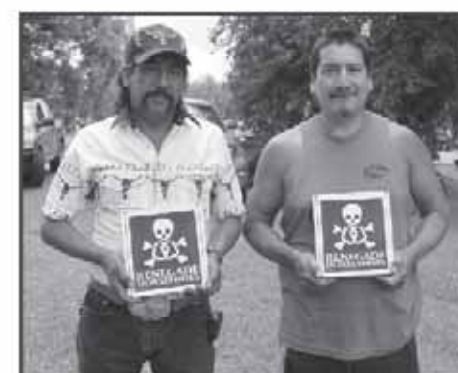

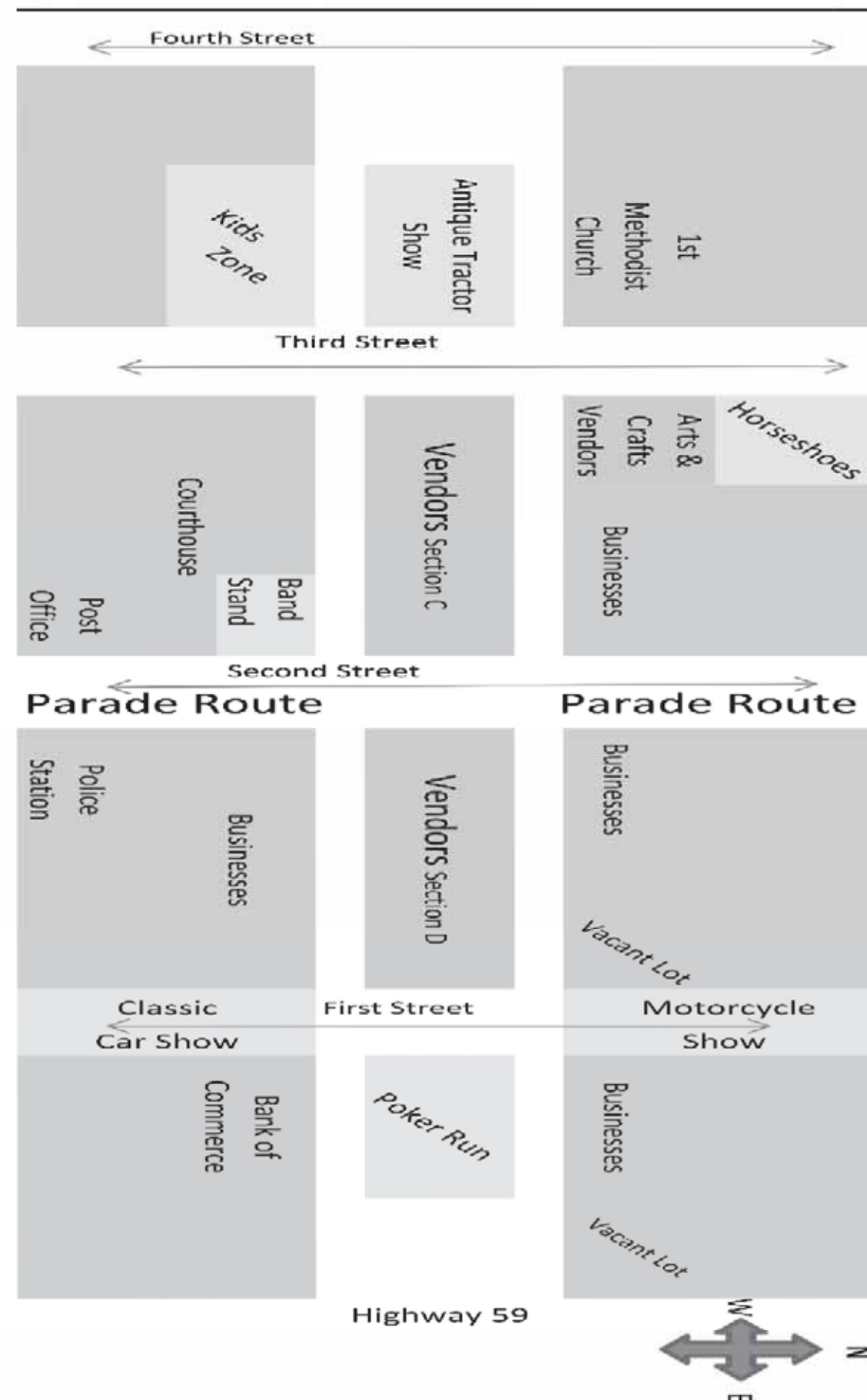

Outstanding Alumni - Bill and Terry Scott



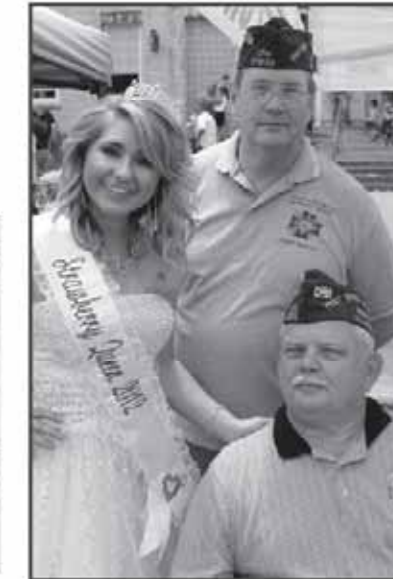
Bill and Terry graduated from Stilwell High school in 1960. Terry attended NSU to pursue her dream of becoming a teacher. She finished in three years. Bill received a football scholarship to the University of Arkansas, and then later transferred to NSU. Bill and Terry married in 1963. They made their first home in Stilwell. Terry taught school in Lincoln, Arkansas while Bill finished his education degree at NSU, and played football. They welcomed their first child, Sherse in 1964.

Terry retired in 1994 and they moved to Stilwell so she could be closer to her parents. Bill coached four years for the Stilwell Indians. In 1986 he was inducted into the Oklahoma Coaches Hall of Fame. In 1999 he was inducted in the NSU Hall of Fame. Later in 2004 he became assistant coach for his son Brent at Tahlequah- Sequoyah. Bill coached for nine years. He retired for the last time in 2012. Bill and Terry have seven grandchildren. They enjoy attending their events and activities. Bill continues to be active in the NSU Alumni Association. They will celebrate 50 years of marriage in August.
