



Marilyn graduated from Stilwell High School in May of 1955. Following high school, Marilyn completed Draughon's Business School in Tulsa, OK and then returned to Stilwell to become a Legal Secretary for her Classmate, David Harris at Harris Law Firm in Stilwell. In 1971 she began employment for the Stilwell Utility Authority and retired after 28 years. Marilyn was elected as Stilwell's first woman Mayor in 1999 serving 4 years and then served as Stilwell City Council Woman for an additional 4 years. During her terms as Mayor and Councilwoman, Marilyn was instrumental in bring new businesses to the City including a Motel and McDonalds and the renovation of the Train Depot and placing a Clock Tower at the Depot site. Marilyn formerly served as Trustee on the NOPFA Gas Authority Board and EODD Board, she is a past member of several other local organizations such as the Study Club, Stilwell Chamber of Commerce, Stilwell High School Quarterback Club and Co-Chair of the Adair County Democrat Party.

Very recently, Marilyn has retired from an 8 years in the Office of the Adair County Election Board as Secretary, an appointment of past Senator Jim Wilson and present Senator Wayne Shaw. Currently Marilyn holds an appointment with the Stilwell Utility Authority Board.



Kiwanis Remembers... J.L. Hallford (1921-2015)



J.L. Hallford was born in Stilwell on February 28, 1921. He passed away on January 22, 2015 at 93 years of age. His early years were spent on a farm in the Zion Community and he attended Zion school. The lessons of hard work he learned on the farm in those early years served him well his entire life. J.L. was a graduate of Stilwell High School. After high school, he honorably served his country in World War II in the US Army Air Corp in the European Theatre. After the war, he returned home and enrolled at Northeastern State University earning a teaching degree. He later earned a Masters degree in education administration from Oklahoma State University.

J.L. initially taught school in the Zion School system and later worked in the Stilwell School System serving as a federal programs officer, principal and administrator for many years. He also served as the elected County Superintendent of Schools for Adair County.

J.L. was very active in the First Christian Church in Stilwell. He served as an Elder and Sunday School teacher for many years. He was a 32nd Degree Mason and a member of the Flint Lodge for over 60 years.

J.L. was an active member of the Stilwell Kiwanis Club for over 60 years and served as President of the club in 1968. J.L. had a great sense of humor and was asked to give the closing story or joke to end the Kiwanis meetings.

J.L. was an avid jogger and won the annual Strawberry Festival Run in his age group 11 times.

A gifted writer, J.L. authored the histories of the First Christian Church, Stilwell Kiwanis Club, Stilwell Strawberry Festival and Masonic Lodge.

Community service was a big part of J.L.'s life. In addition to the areas of service described above, he served on the Stilwell Hospital Board, Stilwell Library Board and in several other organizations.











One word that best describes the Northeastern Oklahoma based Americana band Fifty Nine South is diverse. Each of the five members bring to the stage their own variety of influences that range from Gospel and R&B to Traditional Country and a plethora of Rock music. One thing they all share is producing a sound that draws in and captures their audience.

Originally established in 2003 by Adair County father/son natives Michael & Kyle Brown, Fifty Nine South toured hroughout Oklahoma, Arkansas and Texas. Throughout the early-mid 2000's they shared the stage with acts such as Country Music Star Daryle Singletary and Grammy Award Winning Singer-Songwriter and Actor Ryan Bingham. In 2008, Kyle Brown wrote, co-wrote, and co-produced ten tracks for the band's debut self-titled album on CimSound Records (known for their work with several Red Dirt artists including Cross Canadian Ragweed, Jason Boland & the Stragglers and Red Dirt legends Bob Childers & Randy Crouch). The





The sound of Fifty Nine South has changed over the years, however, the common values and core beliefs remain and grow stronger. Faith, family and their Cherokee heritage are three things that continue to grow deep within the roots of the band.

In the fall of 2013, they debuted their newly formed group on Good Day Tulsa's Morning Show in the mixed company of the unlikely fellow musician, Australian pop singer Cody Simpson. In the days that followed Brown, Doublehead and Robertson

ventured south where they met with Oklahoma native, Texas transplant singer-songwriter and scriptwriter Ray Wylie Hubbard (Snake Farm, Drunken Poet's Dream & Choctaw Bingo) who invited the crew to a live album taping at Dallas' historic Kessler Theater. "Hubbard offered a great insight, a guitar pickin' lesson and a funky groove that we've injected into the vein of our music ever since", says Brown.

The road, though lightly traveled thus far by the newly formed Fifty Nine South, has been greatly influenced by the paths they've crossed and met with great reception by those who they have had the opportunity of performing. "I want people to feel a personal encounter and feel what I am singing. A lot of people can sing, but few can make you feel. My goal is to make my audience feel... whether that be in a church, festival, a concert hall or a small dive bar", Robertson states.
