Our services include 24 hour on-call availability of our firm and staff, including but not limited to, conducting the arrangements conference; planning the funeral; consulting with family and clergy; preparing and filing of necessary

notices; obtaining necessary authorizations and permits; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes our basic overhead costs relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, administrative costs, and equipment and inventory costs.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement, such as direct cremation or immediate burial, that does not require you to pay for it.
