## SACRAMENTAL LIFE

#### RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from 7:30am-7:45am.

On Wednesday from <u>5:30pm-5:45pm</u>. Saturday from <u>3 to 3:45pm</u> in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office. Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

#### **BAPTISM**

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism. Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

#### **CONFIRMATION**

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

#### **MARRIAGE**

Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months. Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.




