Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am-7:45am**.

On Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office. *Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.*

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

My Dear Parishioners,

In many different ways, Scripture tells us to place our hope in the Lord. For Isaiah, hope could be found in the restored Israel. Saint Paul placed his hope in the cross of Christ. In Luke's Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples to rejoice, that their names are written in heaven.

Although Isaiah wrote about two centuries before the Israelites were taken into captivity in Babylon, his prophetic vision points to their exile and return. In the passage from Isaiah, we read today, the exile was over, but Jerusalem has not yet been restored to its former glory. Isaiah assures them that the Lord will comfort them in Jerusalem.

Saint Paul concludes his letter to the Galatians by telling them, that he wishes to triumph and accept the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. When we were baptized, we were marked for Christ with the sign of the cross. We were plunged into the waters of His death and drowned out as a new creation. Every time we make the sign of the cross, it reminds us to whom we belong. Christ suffered and died for us. As His followers, our lives will also be marked by suffering.

In the Gospel of Luke, Jesus appoints 72 of His followers to share in both His mission and His power. In His name they can cure illnesses and cast out demons. Yet He tells them not to rejoice because of this power, but because their names are written in heaven.

Brothers and Sisters,

Like the disciples before us, we are invited to participate in Christ's mission for the salvation of souls. To share in Christ's mission entails sharing in His suffering as well. If like Paul, we bear the marks of our suffering for Christ, then He will recognize Himself in us, when He comes again to judge the living and the dead.

Let us rejoice and thank God for the gift of redemption and the opportunity of salvation which He won for us. May we have the strength to persevere until the end, so that we might claim our place in the new Jerusalem, comforted in the loving arms of God.

Please remember to pray for the Holy Father, Leo XIV, and pray for peace in the world and pray for each other.

What is the Elijah Cup?

The Elijah Cup is a consecrated Chalice which serves as a focal point of prayer for vocations to priesthood, diaconate and religious life, this is a parish-wide effort. Parishioners sign up for a specific week to bring the Elijah Cup home to pray with their families.

Why are we doing this?

Every vocation is needed in the Church, whether to married, consecrated or religious life, but priests in particular hold a very special place in the heart of the Church. Through Holy Orders, they are empowered to serve as a vessel of the Holy Spirit consecrating the bread and wine into the precious Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. In other words, without them, we wouldn't have the Eucharist!

Our archdiocese and our country needs more priests, deacons and religious, and every prayer for them counts. Join us through the Elijah Cup in praying for vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life, and help bring new life into the heart of our Church for generations to come.

How can we pray with the Elijah Cup? What do we do once we get it home?

When you bring the Elijah Cup home, put it in a place of prominence that will be seen by family members each day. Gather together around the Elijah Cup daily to pray for vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life.

This can be a great time to talk with children about what a vocation is – God's call in your life – and to pray together for God's help in discerning their own vocations when the time is right. You can pray from the heart, use a variety of prayers available, or use the prayer card that is included.

sacraments, and community.

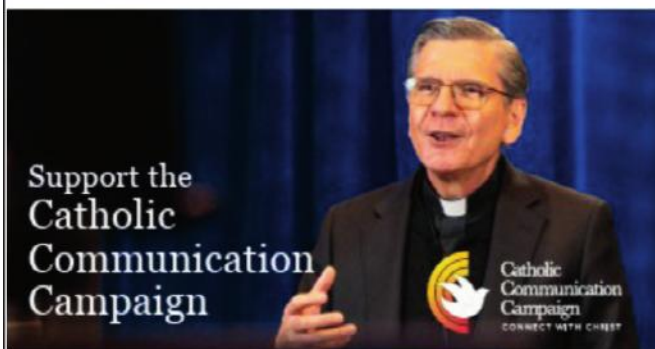

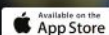
