RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am-7:45am**.

On Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office. *Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.*

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least **six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.

My Dear Parishioners,

I would first like to thank you for your prayers during my surgery and recovery. I am feeling better each day, so I come back to my ministry in the Church and to you.

In today's Gospel parable, the master is away at a wedding feast. In Jesus telling of this story, He focuses on those who await the master's return. They have been given instructions and are expected to carry them out. The servants do not know when the master will return. They wait and make preparation and act in accord with His will. And they are ready. If we put ourselves in the place of the servants with Jesus as the master, here we will find the Good News of the Gospel.

For being ready for Jesus second coming is less about any actual time and place, and more about what we choose to do while we wait. We too have been given instructions and commandments, and there is no time to waste in preparing and participating in God's kingdom. Through the grace of Baptism we have been drafted into Christ, giving us as the Book of Wisdom says – of our ancestors, sure knowledge in which we put our faith. This is the faith which is the realization of what is hoped for – redemption in Jesus Christ. It is this faith that gives us the desire to obey God's call, and the courage to journey wherever God has prepared for us to go.

At the end of the Lord's prayer during Mass, the priest prays in part, "deliver us Lord we pray from every evil – that by the help of your mercy, we may be always free from sin, as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our savior Jesus Christ". This prayer, developing the last petition of the Lord's prayer itself, asks for deliverance from the power of evil for the whole community of the faithful.

So, with prayer and action, we prepare ourselves and one another for the return of our master. We do whatever it means, individually, for each one of us to sell our belongings and give arms and to put our lamps ready, to defend our house from thieves.

Brothers and Sisters,

Let us know God's will and follow Him actively. Let us do these things by God's grace. And we shall rejoice when we once again see the Son of Man – Jesus Christ.

Please remember to pray for the Holy Father, Leo XIV, and for peace in the world.

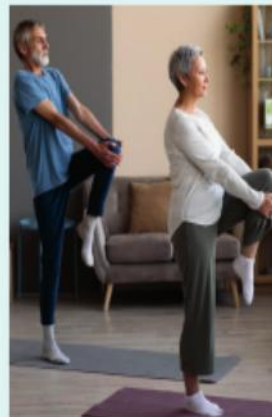

Fast Facts about Falls according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, 2024:

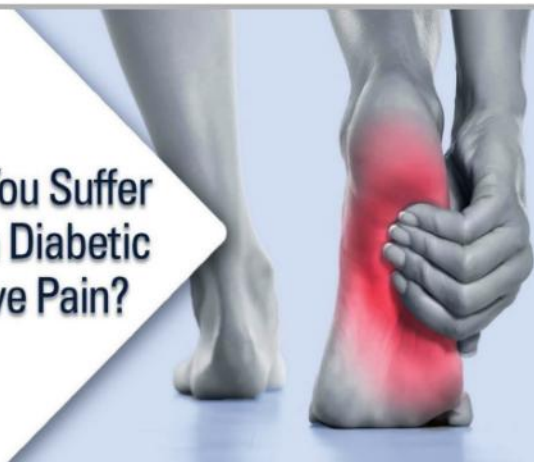
- 1 in 4 people aged 65 and older fall each year and are likely to fall again.
- Falls are the leading cause of injury-related deaths in this age group.
- Approximately 37 million falls occur annually.



Key points for people over 60:

- **Prevalence:** More than 25% of adults aged 65 and older fall each year.
- **Injury rate:** Around 37% of falls result in an injury requiring medical attention or activity restriction.
- **Hospitalization rate:** Nearly one million older adults are hospitalized annually due to fall injuries.
- **Leading cause of fall-related injuries:** Hip fractures, accounting for a large portion of fall-related hospitalizations and deaths.
- **Mortality rate:** Falls are the leading cause of injury-related death among older adults, with the death rate increasing over time.

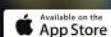
