



RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from 7:30am-7:45am.

On Wednesday from 5:30pm-5:45pm. Saturday from 3 to 3:45pm in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office. Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism. Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months. Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.

My Dear Parishioners,

Today's first reading gives us a familiar scenario – it is about Jeramiah who prophesied in Jerusalem during the reign of king Zedekiah. For many years he had warned the people of Judah about an upcoming disaster. Often referred to as the "weeping prophet," Jeremiah said that the Jewish leadership of the day it is to be finished, the people must worship the one through God alone.

Of course, no one wanted to hear these words. In fact, determined to silence him forever, but to avoid having his blood on their hands. They arrested him and imprisoned him in a cistern. There they hoped he would be forgotten and would die.

As a prophet, Jeremiah brought division. Not because people choosing whether to listen and to follow God's word – or not – but this was in part to divide the community. With a message no one wanted to hear, Jeremiah knew that his fidelity to the Lord could possibly result in death and yet he did not shy away from obeying God's call.

In the Holy Gospel Jesus is on His way to Jerusalem and He tells his disciples that he has come to establish not peace but division. He describes how His message will divide communities and put family members against family members. Relationships will suffer, and He himself will suffer death. As with every previous prophet, those who heard and still hear Jesus' message had the choice to keep it or ignore it. That is what divides. Because when we enter into Christ's baptism with Him, we are united to Him and with each other in His church.

Brothers and Sisters,

Today our lives as Christians are often marked with the same kinds of turmoil as our ancestors. Just as the cross is never too far from the empty tomb, so struggles and suffering are part of the human experience. Yet as Christians we are challenged to keep our eyes firmly fixed on the Lord- never losing sight of His presence and His offer of grace. We are challenged to choose Christ's message, uniting ourselves to and growing strength from all those who walk the pathway of the Christian life with us.

Please remember to pray for the Holy Father, Leo XIV, and for peace in the world.

Fast Facts about Falls according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, 2024:

- 1 in 4 people aged 65 and older fall each year and are likely to fall again.
- Falls are the leading cause of injury-related deaths in this age group.
- · Approximately 37 million falls occur annually.



Key points for people over 60:

- Prevalence: More than 25% of adults aged 65 and older fall each year.
- Injury rate: Around 37% of falls result in an injury requiring medical attention or activity restriction.
- Hospitalization rate: Nearly one million older adults are hospitalized annually due to fall injuries.
- Leading cause of fall-related injuries:
 Hip fractures, accounting for a large portion of fall-related hospitalizations and deaths.
- Mortality rate: Falls are the leading cause of injury-related death among older adults, with the death rate increasing over time.


