

### **RECONCILIATION**

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am-7:45am**.

On Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office. Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

#### **BAPTISM**

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism. Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

#### **CONFIRMATION**

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

#### **MARRIAGE**

Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months. Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.

#### **FUNERAL**

Call the Parish Office (386) 668-8270.





### My Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel Jesus is asked – how many people will be saved. He warns that a place in the kingdom of God is not a given for those who hear Him preach. Jesus tells the people, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate," adding that many will not be strong enough. He then tells them that outsiders from other nations will enter the kingdom of God before them.

We celebrate in our lives that God gives us opportunity after opportunity to repent and strive again for holiness. We encourage people to go to Confession and reclaim their Christian faith. We also acknowledge that our lives are not endless. If we do not strive for holiness in the time we are given, the door will eventually close.

We hear of this kind of discipline in today's second reading of Hebrews. We know that while we are being disciplined it seems more like pain than joy. We also know that good parents discipline their children out of love. God loves us as sons and daughters and therefore disciplines us so that we can be trained to live in peace and righteousness.

We have an opportunity here and now to know Jesus, to discipline ourselves and strive to enter through the narrow gate. How do we respond?

The finest measure of how well we know Jesus is to examine how well we follow His example and His commands. We are invited to focus in a special way on the seven-corporal works of mercy – feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, shelter the homeless, visit the sick and imprisoned, and bury the dead.

Brothers and Sisters,

This week, reject the temptation towards selfishness by acting on the Corporal Works of Mercy.

Decide by yourself or with your family whether you might donate to a food bank, give away gently used clothing or find a way to visit someone who is lonely or ill. Take the opportunity to serve the kingdom of God now, before it is too late.

Please remember to pray for the Holy Father, Leo XIV, and for peace in the world.


