#### RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am-7:45am**.

On Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office. Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

#### **BAPTISM**

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism. Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

#### **CONFIRMATION**

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

#### **MARRIAGE**

Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months. Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.

My Dear Parishioners,

Jesus offers a series of challenging statements into this Gospel. These are words which grab our attention. First, Jesus asks us to hate our own families. Then He asks us to hate our own lives. Finally, He asks us to renounce all our possessions. These, He explains, are the conditions for discipleship. These are the costs we must take into account as we prepare to follow Him.

These things Jesus asks us to renounce are good, so we should not understand His admonitions in this Gospel as difficult calls for the rejection of loved ones or the condemnation of private property. Family is meant to be a school of holiness, a place in which we can exercise our Christlike love. Finally, our possessions are necessary to us-they make it possible for us to live, contribute to society, serve each other, and worship God.

It is possible, to be so consumed by any of these things that we stop looking at Jesus and stop orienting our lives towards Him. A life of discipleship is a life that is oriented toward God and striving to be faithful to Him. The key, therefore, is not that we are asked to give up our family or our possessions, but that we are willing to give these things up for love of God. It is our willingness that makes all the difference.

Discipleship requires sacrifice, He is saying. We are called to make smaller sacrifices each day in order to train ourselves to say, "Yes to our God." Whether it's getting up a little early to pray or being patient with our children, we learn, by our smaller sacrifices, what Jesus means when He asks us to, "hate" even our own lives in order to love Him.

#### Brothers and Sisters,

Today again in our liturgy we become present to Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. He offers himself to His Father in an act of love that cost Him everything. May Jesus grant us a share in His generosity and courage so we might be willing to do whatever it takes to orient our lives on Him.

Dear Parishioners, this weekend at all the Masses immediately following Communion you will hear from a member of the parish about a new program that begins on October 16<sup>th</sup>. The name of the program is "Catholics Returning Home," but don't let the name confuse you. It doesn't mean you're preparing to go to Heaven, it's "An Invitation for Non- Practicing Catholics." You may have family members or friends who are not practicing their faith. Sometimes they have unanswered questions or misunderstandings that this program can help resolve. A member of the team will be outside the Church, under the canopy with additional materials as you leave Mass today.

Please remember to pray for the Holy Father, Leo XIV, and for peace in the world.
