SACRAMENTAL LIFE

RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from 7:30am-7:45am.

On Wednesday from 5:30pm-5:45pm. Saturday from 3 to 3:45pm in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office. Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism. Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months. Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.

Order of Christian Initiation for Adults

Have you been considering become Catholic? Do you know someone who has a desire to become Catholic? Formation for anyone wanting to enter into the Catholic faith through the Order of Christian Initiation (OCIA) begins in October.

While OCIA is focused on the unbaptized, it is also for adult Catholics who have not received all the sacraments of initiation (communion and confirmation), and Christians from other faiths who desire to be received into full communion of the Catholic Church.

Often people attend Mass at a parish for months or sometimes years, but <u>never officially register</u>.




Registering at St. Ann's Catholic Church is the expression of your commitment to be a part of our parish community.


