#### RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from 7:30am-7:45am.

On Wednesday from 5:30pm-5:45pm.
Saturday from 3 to 3:45pm in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office.
Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

#### **BAPTISM**

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism. Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

#### **CONFIRMATION**


Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

#### **MARRIAGE**

Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months. Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.

My Dear Parishioners,

Each year on November 9 we celebrate the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica. Why is that? It is easy to understand why we commemorate saints, but why a building? It could be argued that it is the Pope's Church, the official seat of the Bishop of Rome. While this papal connection provides status, it does not earn the right to have a full day dedicated to it. If that was the case, then St. Peter's Basilica should be honored as well.

It has earned this right because this was the first public building granted to the Christians by Rome, when Constantine made Christianity legal - bringing decades of persecution to an end. While this was a significant event, certainly worth commemorating, the early Church saw this as confirmation of their belief in the risen Christ, who is the cornerstone of their faith for them, this first Cathedral Church symbolized Christian Community.

They understood, as Saint Paul suggested to the community in Corinth, "no one can lay a foundation other than the one that is there, namely Jesus Christ."

The Lateran Basilica is the official cathedral for every Pope in the history. It is intended to serve as a symbol of how faith in Christ will triumph over evil. The history of this basilica testifies to this truth. Being destroyed numerous times, it was always rebuilt, signifying how the Church, with Christ as it's foundation, can never be held down.

The Church will survive. The body of Christ will survive. No matter how it may be attached from outside or within the Lateran reminds us that our faith built on the foundation of Christ can never be destroyed. This foundation gives us hope. As Saint Paul taught the Corinthians, we are the temple of God and the Spirit of God dwells within us. Even though we may face challenges in our faith, if Christ is our foundation, we will never be defeated.

The Lateran Basilica reminds us that whenever we gather as a community, we do so with the knowledge that our Church building, and each one of us, is a dwelling place of God. Both remind us of the need to reverence our sacred spaces and respect ourselves and one another who image the very God we worship.

Brothers and Sisters,

Please continue to pray for peace in the world, stop the violence and wars. Also, in this special month of November, pray for our deceased members in our parish, in our families and friends.






