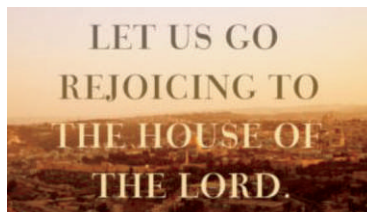

RECONCILIATION

BAPTISM

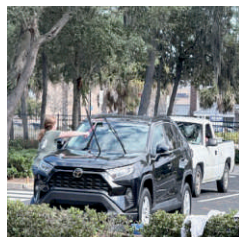

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

With Father Andrzej's approval and blessing, this annual financial report is presented to you. It presents a summary of the Parish Financial Report that is submitted annually to the Diocese of Orlando. It is intended to provide you with a basic overview and accountability of how our parish has lived our mission for the year ending June 30, 2025.

For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, total operating revenues were \$1,306,084, while total operating expenditures were \$1,181,402, resulting in an excess of revenues over expenditures over of \$124,682. Revenues increased \$116,855 in 2025, mostly due to increases in Offertory of \$32,756, Diocesan Collections of \$18,380, Other Collections / Donations of \$14,901 and Investment Income of \$46,992. Expenditures increased \$45,006, mostly due to increases in Church Expenditures of \$12,576, Diocesan Collections of \$19,125, Office Salaries and Expenses of \$40,003, Repairs and Maintenance of \$40,715 and Payroll Taxes and Benefits of \$9,192, net of decreases in capital expenditures of \$72,352.

Included in those revenues and expenditures are our collection and assessment for Our Catholic Appeal. Collections for Our Catholic Appeal for the fiscal year exceeded our assessment from the Diocese as collections were \$169,953 compared to our assessment of \$148,855.

This year because of your continued support of the Renew, Restore and Rebuild Monthly collection we were able to continue projects on our campus. This included the installation of a new updated fire alarm system in our church. In the Education Building, additional security steps were taken to ensure a safer Faith Formation program by adding security film on all entrance doors. Every classroom lock was replaced with ADA Compliant Door locks, and window shades were installed. The Parish Office has been repainted, and old carpet has been replaced with waterproof vinyl plank flooring. The rest of the year all required maintenance and repairs of all buildings were done.

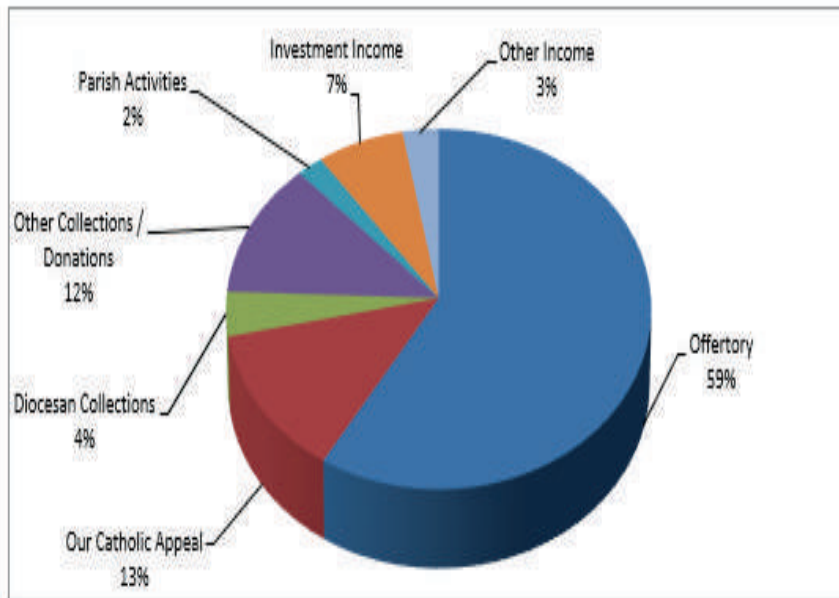
An extra project was completed thanks to a ministry group endeavor; the Council of Catholic Women, the Knights of Columbus, and the Bring Your Own Project-Stiches members supported a complete update to the Parish Hall sound system.

Operating Revenues

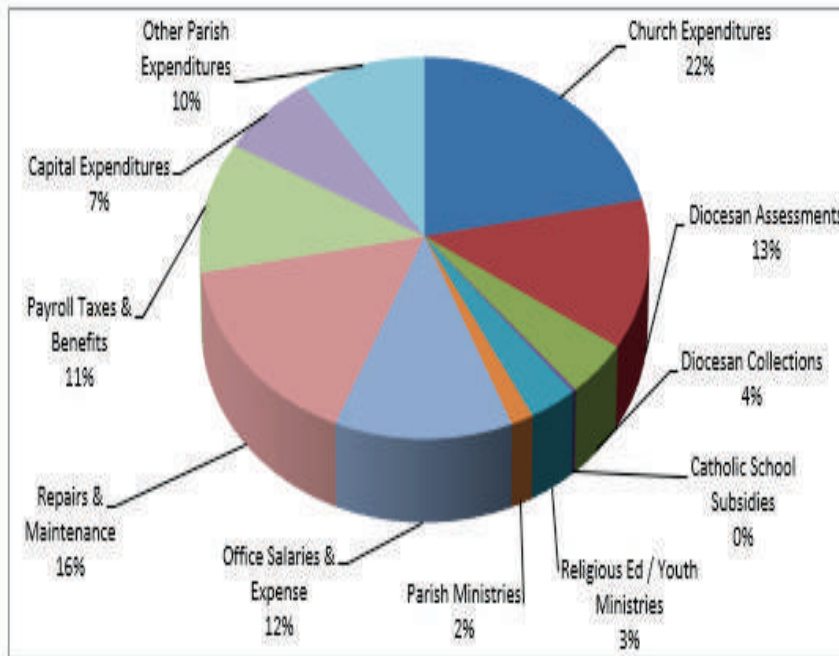
