BAPTISM

Confirmation is celebrated annually
for the ninth grade students who have
completed a two-year preparation program.
Adults who wish to be confirmed should
call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least
**six months in advance. The Catholic party
must be a registered active member of our
parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are
usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am

My Dear Parishioners,

Today with great joy we celebrate GAUDETE SUNDAY!

In today's first reading, Isaiah's beautiful poem proclaims the dry earth of the dessert will bloom with abundant flowers, and the glory of Lebanon will be given. Throughout his writing Isaish references Lebanon as an iconic place of beauty. Contrary to the barren hills surrounding Jerusalem, Lebanon was known for its rich cedar forests. Isaish employs this image to foreshadow what the Christian scripture calls the "New Heaven and Earth," or the restoration of creation, including humanity, to God's original intent. This is a fitting image for Advent, as we prepare for heaven to literally come to earth.

Each of us is a work in progress. Everyday, we are being transformed as part of Christ's mission of restoration and redemption. Sometimes the growth we undergo feels painfully slow, as though we are barely progressing. Sometimes it feels that we are not growing into something beautiful but rather being overcome by thorns.

Amidst some moments we can return to the prophet Isaish's words, "Say to those who hearts are frightened – be strong, fear not!" This poem of joyful hope goes on to say, "here is your God, He comes with vindication." So, too, we must wait with hope, enduring on our sad backs with faithfulness and patience. In the second reading, St. James offers further encouragement when he says, "make your hearts firm, because the coming of the Lord is at hand."

In Matthew's gospel Jesus words continue the theme of the first reading when He tells John the Baptist disciples, "go and tell John what you hear and see." People are heard and the Good News is proclaimed to the poor, just as Isaish predicted. Jesus assures the crowd, "that He is the one who is to come." Jesus rejoices in John's mission of preparing the way for Him, Jesus says there is no one greater than John and yet the least in the Kingdom of Heaven is greater than He.

What does this mean for us?

John Baptized with water and Jesus baptized with the Holy Spirit. Jesus dies for the forgiveness of our sins and gives us His body to eat. When He promises to be with us always, we are blessed to be included in His kingdom.

So, Brothers and Sisters,

Let us rejoice on this Gaudete Sunday in what Jesus has done for us. Let us prepare our hearts not only for His coming but for His kingdom.

Please continue to pray for peace in the world, stop the violence and wars.
