RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am-7:45am**.

On Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office.

Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least **six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.

My Dear Parishioners,

I hope you had a wonderful, blessed celebration of Jesus Christ Birthday. In our Catholic Tradition on the Sunday after Christmas we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family-Jesus, Mary and Joseph. We seek to follow the example of St. Joseph, the Blessed Mother and the Christ child, as they sought to live the life of a holy family. They offer our families an example of what it means to live in holiness and faith.

The first thing we should note as we hear today's scriptures is that the Holy Family knew its own share of challenge and hardship. They were forced to travel far from home during the risky time of Mary's pregnancy, leading to their son's birth in a rough place and in conditions less than ideal. Shortly after the birth of Jesus, they are told that they must flee for their lives and the life of their newborn Son. They travel to a distant land until they receive the message that it is safe for them to return. Their challenges resemble the challenges we experience in our own family lives.

The second thing we should note about the Holy Family is that in faith they listen for and are open to God's guidance in their lives. Both Mary and Joseph received angelic visitors who share challenging news with them. Their trust in and open totally to God, and this is model for us to follow. Their family is guided by God, and they teach us to do the same.

One final thing we can note about the Holy Family is that they demonstrate the importance of the values held up for us in the second reading. Kindness, humility, gentleness and patience must have been theirs as they adopted to changing circumstances, new surroundings, and unseen challenges.

This Feast of the Holy Family holds up for us the example of simple trust and openness to God, and the faith which they shared. They show us that our families, even in the times of challenge, can also be holy families-settings in which each of us can grow in kindness, humility, gentleness and peace. With faith and trust in God, we too, experience family life in all it's uncertainty and wonderous beauty. May the Holy Family which we honor in a special way today will bless our Family Parish at St. Ann's and each family in our parish.
