RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am-7:45am**, and on Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**.

Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office.

Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least **six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.

Palm Sunday begins the Holiest Week of the Church's year. We begin with Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem and walk with Him through the commemoration of His Passion to the celebration of His resurrection at Easter. You are all invited to journey together as one parish family!


The 2026 Chrism Mass in the Diocese of Orlando is scheduled for **Monday, March 30, 2026, at 11am**. It will be held at Holy Family Catholic Church, located at 5125 S. Apopka Vineland Road, Orlando. The Mass will also be available to watch via livestream on the diocesan YouTube channel. Bishop Noonan will bless the Holy Oils which each priest will take back to their parish to be used to anoint their parishioners receiving the sacraments.

The liturgy is so rich and flooded with ritual that it takes three days to commemorate, especially the Triduum Paschalis:

- **Holy Thursday, April 2 – begins at 7pm**, we will celebrate the Mass of the Last Supper during this Holy Mass and will give special thanks to Jesus for instituting the Holy Eucharist and the Sacrament of the Holy Orders, Priesthood.
- **Good Friday – at noon we will have the Stations of the Cross** and then **two services at 3 & 7pm**. On this day we celebrate the Lord's Passion and Death. In the first part of the Liturgy, we listen to God's Word and strive to understand the true meaning of His sufferings. In the second part of the Liturgy, we venerate reverently the Cross which now has become the glorious symbol of Jesus triumph and of our redemption. In the third part of the Liturgy, we simply receive Holy Communion reserved from yesterday's celebration of the Lord's Supper.
- **Saturday - the Easter Vigil begins at 8pm**. At the beginning we will bless the new Paschal candle, listen to God's Words, and bless the baptismal water. We will renew our Baptismal promises and we will be sprinkled with the new baptismal water. That evening we welcome new members of the Catholic Church who will receive the Sacraments of Initiation- Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion.
- Another tradition is the **blessing of the Easter Baskets/Easter food** which takes place on **Saturday at noon** in the Church.

Please continue to pray as we are coming closer to the celebration of the Easter Vigil and the Resurrection Sunday. Please keep in your prayers the elects and catechumens, also pray for each other, and pray for me.

Fast and Abstinence Guidelines

Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the Parish Priest should be consulted. Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent.

The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for Baptism or renewal of Baptism at Easter.

Chrism Mass




Monday, March 30, 11 a.m., will be at Holy Family Parish, located at 5125 S. Apopka Vineland Road, Orlando, via livestream.
