RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am** to **7:45am**, and on Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office.
Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least **six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call Zee at the Parish Office before setting any dates, (386) 668-8270.

My Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, the central mystery of our Christian Faith. We believe in a Triune God - One God, two natures, three persons-Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The doctrine of the Trinity is not only the central mystery of our faith and life but is the source of all the other mysteries of faith. The whole Church's life flows from this central belief, and it reveals who God is, and how we are meant to be united to Him.

Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. When we make the sign of the cross, we do so using the name of each person of the Trinity. All through the Mass, the Trinity is invoked- in the Gloria, The Collect, and The dismissal, and everywhere in between. Our prayer is at rest to the Father but offered through Jesus Christ in the unity of the Holy Spirit-God forever and ever. During the Eucharistic Prayers, we ask the Father to send the Spirit so that our gifts of bread and wine might become for us the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

In a few moments we will profess our Creed, which in its own right is a short course of Trinitarian Theology. The words signify not human gender but divine relationships.

The relationship of the divine persons is one of perfect unity and communion. Everything that belongs to one belongs to the other, and yet each is not the same as the other. Our Triune God is three divine persons who are consubstantial and eternal, and who are all adored and glorified. It is true that totality of the triune God that love and grace flow on us as Christ faithful people.

In celebrating the Trinity, the Church is not simply laying out a doctrine of complex theology. It is bringing to the forefront what should be the foundational principle of our lives-God is love, He made us for love, and He desires that we will live in this love with Him forever. As John the evangelist wrote in the Gospel – “God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life.”

Brothers and Sisters,

Please continue to pray for peace in the world and the end to wars and violence. Pray also for our parish family and for my special intention.

THE SACRIFICE OF THE MASS - GESTURES AND RITUALS WITH SIMPLE EXPLANATIONS - PART 2

Participant or Spectator?

All too often we hear Catholics say they get nothing out of Mass. Perhaps it is because they do not know the meaning of all that is happening on the Altar. We should be participants with the Priest in offering the Sacrifice of the Mass and not just spectators. We can enjoy, appreciate and participate with the Priest when we know the meaning and reasons for the prayers and rituals throughout the Mass.

The Priest gives the Deacon a blessing before proclaiming the Good News of the Gospel. "The Lord be in your heart and on your lips that you may worthily proclaim His gospel. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."



Gestures before Gospel Reading. We make the sign of the Cross on our forehead, lips and breast before the Gospel reading to symbolize a prayer to God to enlighten our understanding, to make us ready to profess it with our lips, and to open our hearts to receive His sacred teaching.



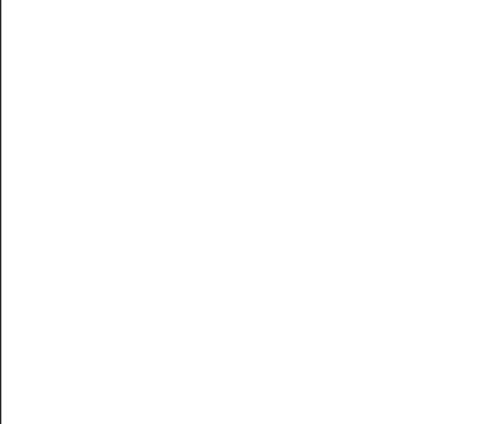
