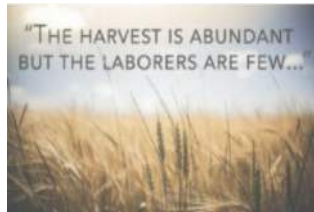

SACRAMENTAL LIFE

RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am** to **7:45am**, and on Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office.
Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least **six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call Zee at the Parish Office **before** setting any dates, (386) 668-8270.

THE SACRIFICE OF THE MASS - GESTURES AND RITUALS WITH SIMPLE EXPLANATIONS



Participant or Spectator? All too often we hear Catholics say they get nothing out of Mass. Perhaps it is because they do not know the meaning of all that is happening on the Altar. We should be participants with the Priest in offering the Sacrifice of the Mass and not just spectators. We can enjoy, appreciate and participate with the Priest when we know the meaning and reasons for the prayers and rituals throughout the Mass.

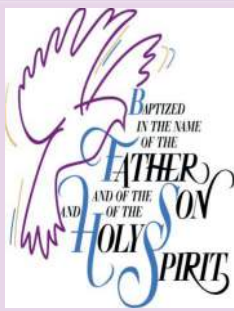
The Priest washes his hands to remind himself and the people of the cleanliness and purity of soul and body with which we ought to appear before the Lord.

While washing his hands the Priest says: "Wash me, O Lord, from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin."



The Priest extends his hands over the gifts to be consecrated in imitation of the ancient ceremony whereby the officiating priest would lay his hands upon the head of the sacrificial victim while saying prayers of petition. In the New Testament, the Priest says the following prayer to the Holy Spirit with his hands extended over the gifts: "O Lord, we humbly implore You: by the same Spirit graciously make holy these gifts we have brought to You for consecration, that they may become the Body and Blood of Your Son our Lord Jesus Christ, at whose command we celebrate these mysteries."


