RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am** to **7:45am**, and on Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office.
Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least **six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call Zee at the Parish Office **before** setting any dates, (386) 668-8270.

My Dear Parishioners,

HAPPY FATHERS DAY!



FOCUS: God is with us as we bear witness to the truth.

For anyone who has ever been afraid to speak the truth, today's readings should be a source of strength and encouragement. Just prior to the passage we hear in today's first reading, Jeremiah prophesies that Judah will suffer under the Babylonians for their refusal to repent. Because of this Jeremiah is beaten and imprisoned in stocks overnight. Our reading picks up at this point – we hear Jeremiah speak about the problems all around him as he feels the full cost of his faithfulness to God.

In our own lives, we know that truth-telling can come with heavy costs. Taking a public stand for Gospel values sometimes brings push back or ridicule. People who speak out against injustice may risk losing their jobs or face problems. People who urge family members to correct harmful behaviors often face being cut off from their loved ones.

While we know there can be real challenges in bearing witness to the truth, our readings give reason for hope. Even amid persecution, God will be with us. Despite his arrest Jeremiah praises God – “But the Lord is with me, like a mighty champion, my persecutor's will stumble, they will not triumph.” Like Jeremiah we can rejoice even amid persecution and suffering because the Lord is with us.

In the Gospel, Jesus further reassures us that – “not one sparrow falls to the ground without your Father's knowledge. Even all the hairs of your head are counted. So do not be afraid, you are worth more than many sparrows.” In these simple verses, Jesus is telling us that we are each precious to God. Nothing happens to us without His knowledge. We can rest in the knowledge that God will not allow anything outside of His will to happen to us as we bear witness to His truth.

As we come to the Eucharist today, let us thank the Lord for His presence with us and ask for His strength as we strive to bear witness to His truth. May we proclaim from the roof tops what God has spoken to us; may we bring the light of His truth to our world.

Brothers and Sisters,

Let us pray together for all our fathers, living and deceased on this special day as we celebrate Father's Day and please continue to pray for peace in the world and the end to wars and violence. Pray also for our parish family and for my special intention.

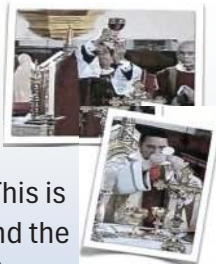

Participant or Spectator? All too often we hear Catholics say they get nothing out of Mass. Perhaps it is because they do not know the meaning of all that is happening on the Altar. We should be participants with the Priest in offering the Sacrifice of the Mass and not just spectators. We can enjoy, appreciate and participate with the Priest when we know the meaning and reasons for the prayers and rituals throughout the Mass.

Elevation after Consecration
The Priest holds up the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ for the adoration of the Faithful. This is an opportunity to join Christ and the priest in offering this sacrifice to God the Father in reparation for your sins, those of your family, and the wants of the whole Church.



Priest makes an Act of Adoration. After the transubstantiation Of the bread and wine into the Sacred Body and the Precious Blood of Christ, the Priest genuflects and adores Our Lord...Our Eucharistic Lord.


