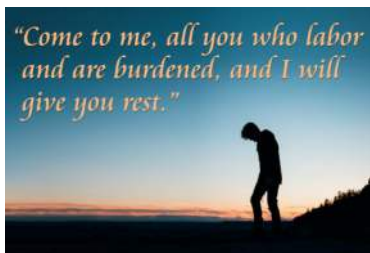

RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am** to **7:45am**, and on Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office.
Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least **six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call Zee at the Parish Office **before** setting any dates, (386) 668-8270.

THE SACRIFICE OF THE MASS - GESTURES AND RITUALS WITH SIMPLE EXPLANATIONS

Participant or Spectator? All too often we hear Catholics say they get nothing out of Mass. Perhaps it is because they do not know the meaning of all that is happening on the Altar. We should be participants with the Priest in offering the Sacrifice of the Mass and not just spectators. We can enjoy, appreciate and participate with the Priest when we know the meaning and reasons for the prayers and rituals throughout the Mass.



Priest's Communion - As he receives the Host he quietly prays: "May the Body of Christ keep me safe for eternal life."

As he receives the Chalice he prays: "May the Blood of Christ keep me safe for eternal lie."



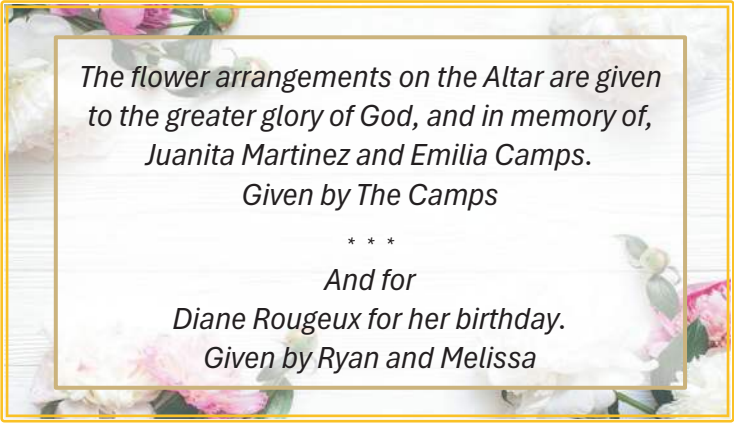
These prayers can be said quietly by everyone before receiving Communion.

Prayer Posture - Prayer: Raising up the mind and heart to God. By closing one's eyes, which are considered the windows of the soul, a person can shut out distractions and better concentrate and meditate on the meaning of the words of the prayers being said.


