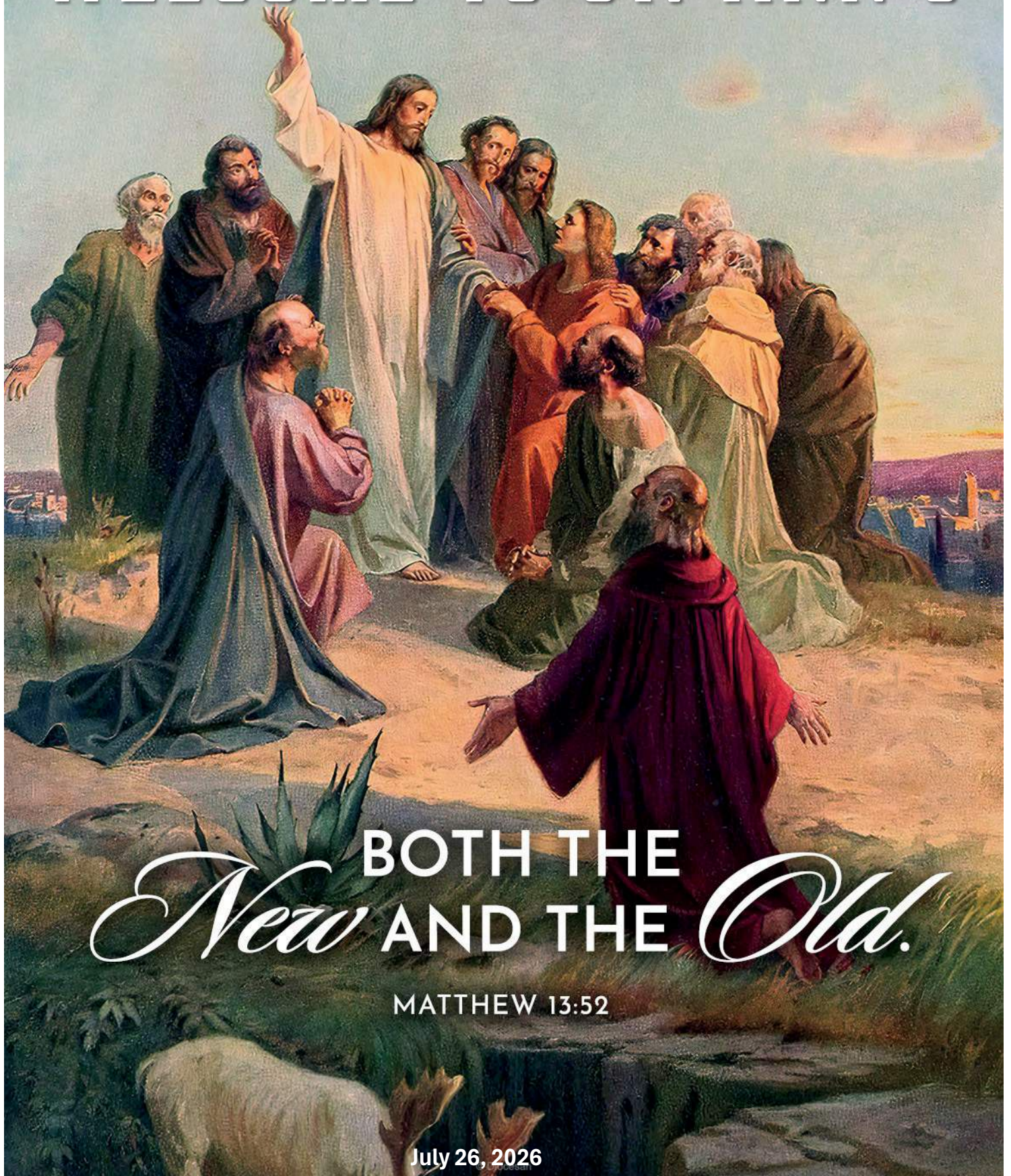

RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am** to **7:45am**, and on Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office.
Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least **six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call Zee at the Parish Office **before** setting any dates, (386) 668-8270.

Saints Joachim and Anne's Story

In 2021, Pope Francis established the 4th Sunday in July as the **World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly**, near to the Feast Day of Saints Joachim and Anne.

This weekend we celebrate the Feast honoring the parents of the Virgin Mary and Jesus' earthly grandparents. We also honor our own grandparents and the elderly in our lives who are such a blessing to us.

Although there is no mention of Saints Joachim and Anne in the Bible, (what we know comes from Catholic legend and writings of the first and second centuries), what we do know of them, we see in Mary. Her devotion to her faith, her trust in God, her continuous practice of prayer, and her devotion to her relatives—all reveal a faithful and loving family. It was Saints Anne and Joachim who nurtured in the young Mary a love for God, that prepared her for her role in our redemption.

Fr. Isaac Honsan representing the **Archdiocese of Imphal, India** will speak at all masses the **weekend of August 1-2**.

“As part of our Social commitment to the poor and needy, the diocese is launching a special grass-root level Rural Community Health Workers Training Program in the tribal villages of Manipur State. This proposed 10-month program is designed to train village health workers who will serve some of the most vulnerable and remote communities where access to medical care and clean drinking water remains limited. Through this mission, trained health workers will help educate rural families about the prevention and treatment of diseases such as malaria, viral fever, tuberculosis, typhoid, pneumonia, polio, and other waterborne illnesses. Along with health awareness programs, rural medical camps will also be organized with the help of Catholic Medical Hospital, Imphal to provide basic treatment and care to those who otherwise have little or no medical assistance.

As part of this life-saving mission, the Archdiocese is undertaking this large-scale primary health care initiative with hope and compassion for the poor and suffering.”

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Struggling with Grief? Re-Membering Bereavement Support Group will begin a six week session on

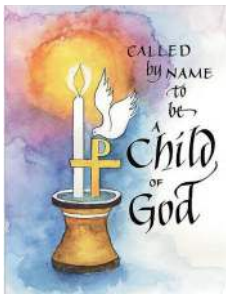
