RECONCILIATION

Reconciliation is celebrated daily Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday from **7:30am-7:45am**.

On Wednesday from **5:30pm-5:45pm**. Saturday from **3 to 3:45pm** in the Church's Chapel or by a prearranged appointment with the Priest in the Parish Office. *Schedule may vary during Holy Days of Obligation.*

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious obligation. **Parents must be registered, active members of the parish for three months prior to the Baptism.** Call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually for the ninth grade students who have completed a two-year preparation program. Adults who wish to be confirmed should call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least **six months in advance. The Catholic party must be a registered active member of our parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before setting any dates.

My Dear Parishioners,

God calls us to humble service

Today's readings emphasize the importance of humility. The Book of Sirach says, "to humble yourself more the greater you are, and you will find favor with God." This message is echoed in the parable about a wedding banquet that Jesus tells in today's Gospel reading. Invited guests should not sit in the place of honor. Otherwise, when a more distinguished guest arrives, they will be asked to move down to the lowest place. They should choose to sit at the lowest place at the beginning. Then when the host invites them to sit at a higher place. They will be esteemed.

Jesus continues, telling His hosts that when He holds a banquet, he should not invite his friends, relatives, and wealthy neighbors who might then repay the favor by inviting him in return. Instead, he should invite those who are unable to repay, for then he will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous.

Brothers and Sisters,

God is generous to us, in ways that we know we can never repay. He is instructing us to be as open and free in our own generosity to others. As we have received, so should we give. The kingdom can be grown and nurtured only through our invitation of God's love, manifested in Jesus Christ. We need to recognize that it is the humility of Christ who became man that opened the way to our invitation to the heavenly banquet. Thus, we serve Him when we are humble like Him.

There is a connection between humility and service. With humility, we see ourselves clearly. We do our duty and avoid what is beyond our strength. We think about others more than ourselves. We need to remember when we are guests, we take the lowest place. When we are hosts, we invite the lowest.

Brothers and Sisters, every Sunday we are invited to a wedding banquet, a feast at which we renew our covenant with Christ. We cannot hope to repay Christ for the give He has given us. Instead, we are called to imitate His humility and loving service.

We are called to pour ourselves out to our brothers and sisters in the same way He has poured Himself out for us.

Dear Parishioners, please remember to pray for the Holy Father, Leo XIV, and for peace in the world. Also, I humbly ask you to pray for your priests this week- Fr. James and myself- as we will attend our Annual Priestly Convocation with our Bishop John Noonan.

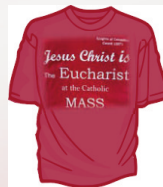
