

Chapel or by a prearranged appointment
with the Priest in the Parish Office.
*Schedule may vary during Holy Days of
Obligation.*

BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is a serious
obligation. **Parents must be registered,
active members of the parish for three
months prior to the Baptism.** Call the
Parish Office to make arrangements.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation is celebrated annually
for the ninth grade students who have
completed a two-year preparation program.
Adults who wish to be confirmed should
call the Parish Office for more information.

MARRIAGE

Arrangements must be made at least
**six months in advance. The Catholic party
must be a registered active member of our
parish for at least 4 months.** Weddings are
usually celebrated on Saturdays at 11am
and 1pm. Call the Parish Office before
setting any dates.




