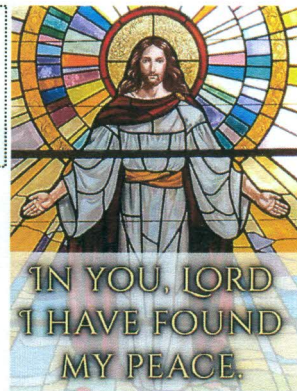

As for you, do not be called 'Rabbi.' . . . . Call no one on earth your father ... Do not be called 'Master' . . . ." (Mt 23:8-10)

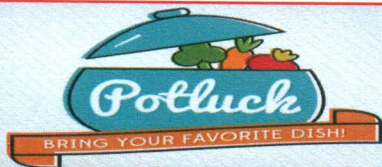
Jesus gives a stinging criticism of the scribes and the Pharisees and warns his disciples not to follow their example. But he does tell them that the religious leaders have authority that comes from the chair of Moses. That means that when they speak and teach, they are teaching authentic teaching, that will lead the people closer to God. But they do not put their own teaching into practice in their own lives.

How difficult it is to always practice what we preach or teach! Any father or mother of a family knows it is not easy to lead by example. Letting children see our behavior teaches more than telling them how to behave. In fact, anyone in authority, whether in the family or society at large, can easily fall into thinking that what is good for others does not apply to me. Jesus calls us to practice what we preach.

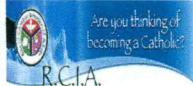
