Dear Tiara Noel:

This letter will serve as formal notification of actions taken by the National League for Nursing Commission for Nursing Education Accreditation (NLN CNEA) with respect to the Andrew College Associate Degree in Nursing Program at its October 8-9, 2025 Board of Commissioners' meeting. In particular, the Board reviewed the prior materials including the Program's Self-study Report, On-site Program Evaluation Site Visit Team Report, Third-party Comments, the Response to the On-site Program Evaluation Site Visit Team Report, and the Program Review Committee's Report. The Board of Commissioners also reviewed the Show Cause Report that was submitted September 9, 2025.

Upon review of this information, the Board of Commissioners noted that the program has resolved the substantial and continued compliance concerns with the following Standards and Quality Indicators: III-A, V-C, V-J. Additionally, the Board has reclassified the noncompliance concern for Standard I, Quality Indicator I-C to a quality improvement concern. The quality improvement concern in I-C will be addressed in the letter regarding the Program's continuing accreditation status, file titled "AND 02 CONT ACC Decision 10.25". Accordingly, the Board has vacated the Program's Show Cause Directive as of October 8, 2025.

You may share this updated accreditation status with your stakeholders and remove the information regarding the Show Cause Directive from any program publications.
