Curriculum Vitae (CV) Guidelines

- Submit CV as a PDF file
- Limited to 15 pages
- For lengthy, extensive careers and to stay within the 15 page limit, you may focus your CV on the last 10 years of accomplishments, listing most recent accomplishments first in each category
- Emphasize, as appropriate, your involvement in program evaluation, curriculum development, accreditation or certification activities (in education or practice)
- Include the following, as applicable:
 - Education
 - Employment history
 - Awards and honors
 - Publications
 - Presentations
 - Grants (funded only)
 - Research
 - Magnet recognition activities
 - Committee appointments pertinent to curriculum evaluation, program evaluation, institution or program accreditation/certification activities
 - Board experience
 - Institution/program evaluation experience
 - Professional activities
- YOU DO **NOT** NEED TO INCLUDE: Courses taught, theses/dissertations supervised, detailed job descriptions, publications in process, community service, or continuing education.

Personal and Professional Statement Guidelines

- Submit statement as a PDF file
- Limited to two pages double-spaced
- Address why you want to serve the NLN CNEA. Briefly address your ability to apply the core values of the NLN (caring, diversity and inclusion, excellence, integrity) to the NLN CNEA accreditation process
