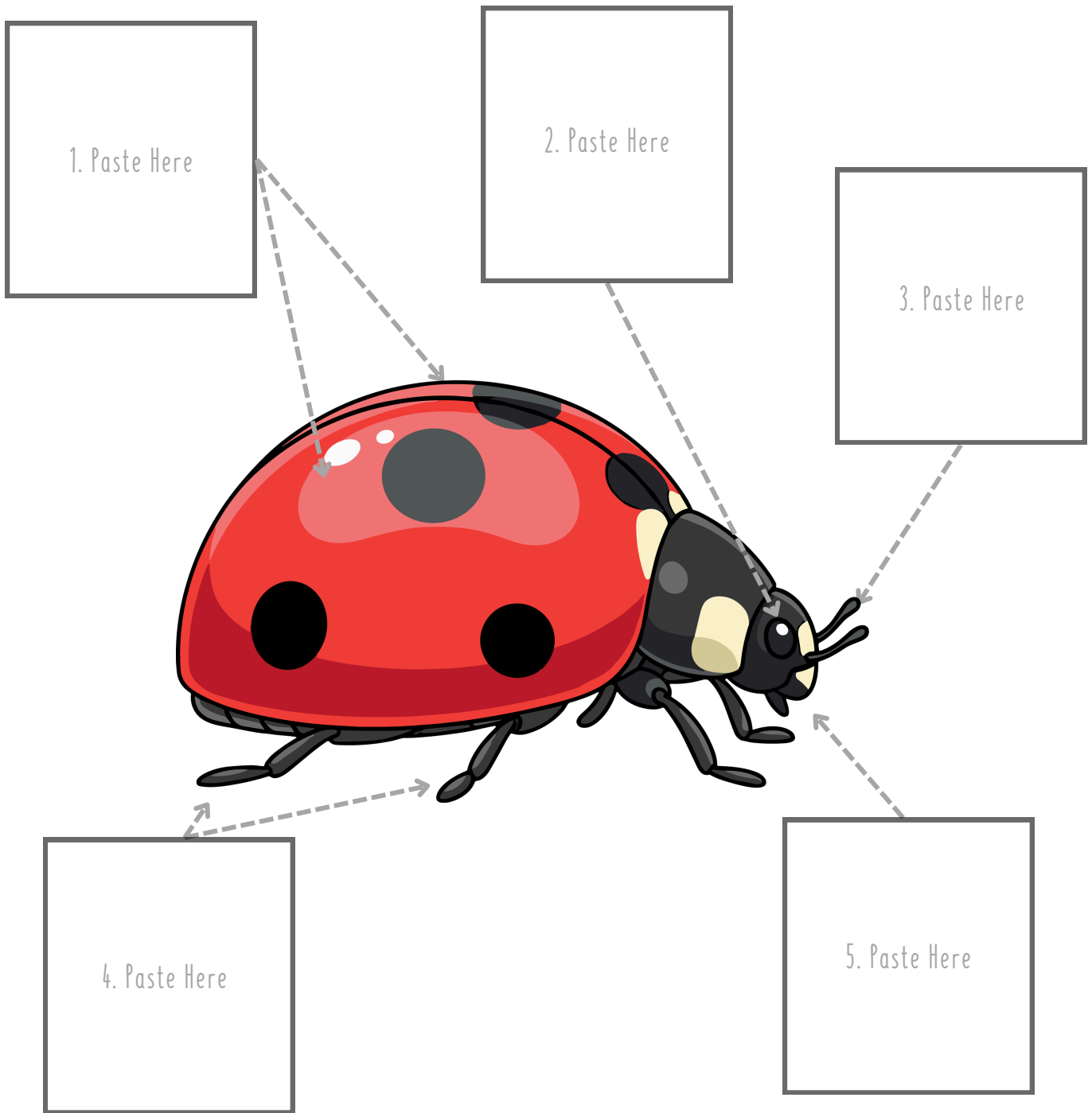


LADYBUG LABELING

LEGS

Like all insects, ladybugs have 6 legs that allow them to walk and climb.

ELYTRA

These are brightly colored and protect a ladybug's soft wings.

MANDIBLES

Ladybugs have mouthparts called mandibles. They work like teeth to chew up food.

ANTENNAE

Ladybugs use their antennae for feeling and smelling.

COMPOUND EYES

These special eyes give ladybugs a great sense of sight.
