For each problem on pages 2-4, think about how an orangutan would solve it using resources found in their habitat.

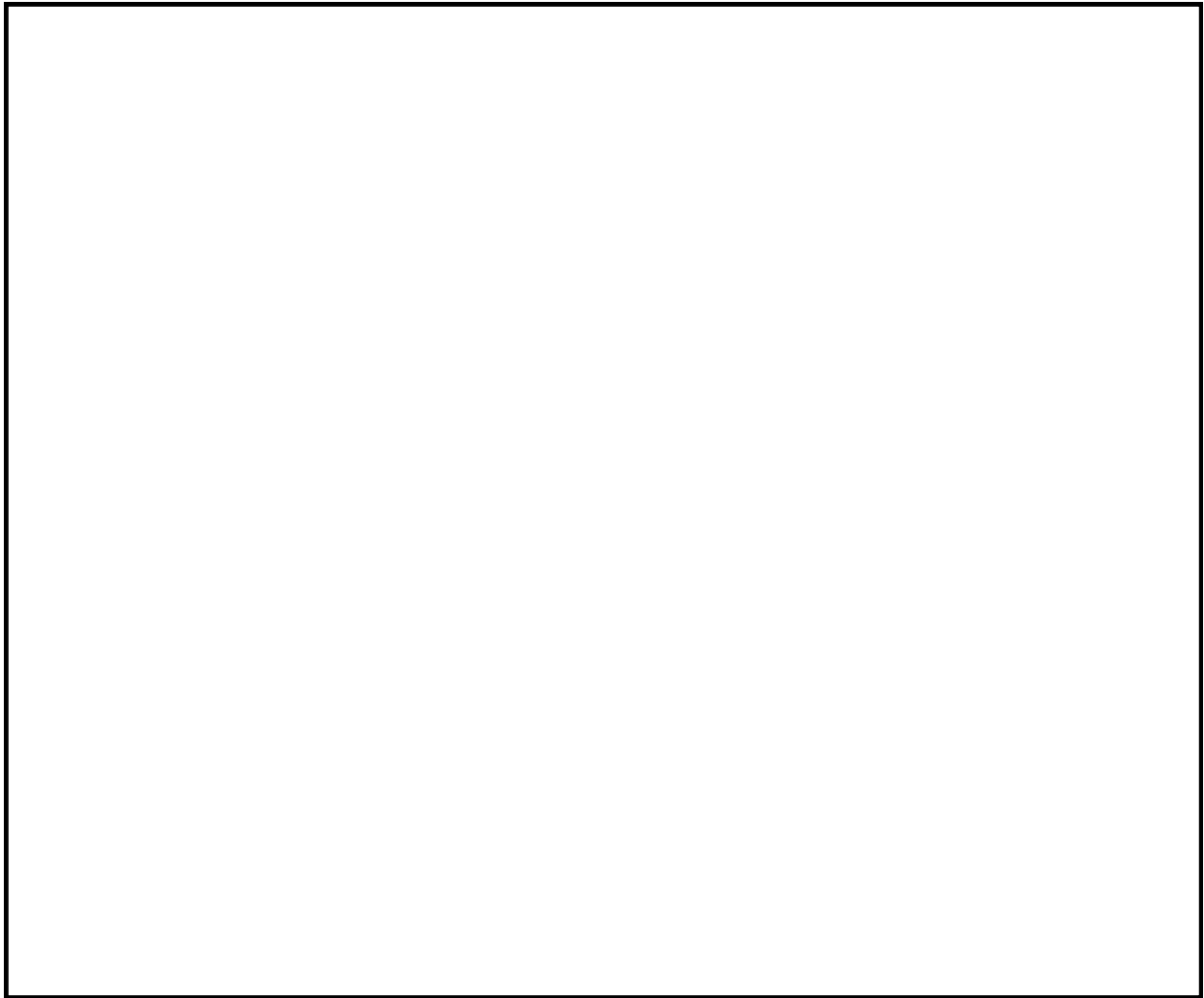
Then, draw and color an orangutan using the tool to solve the problem!

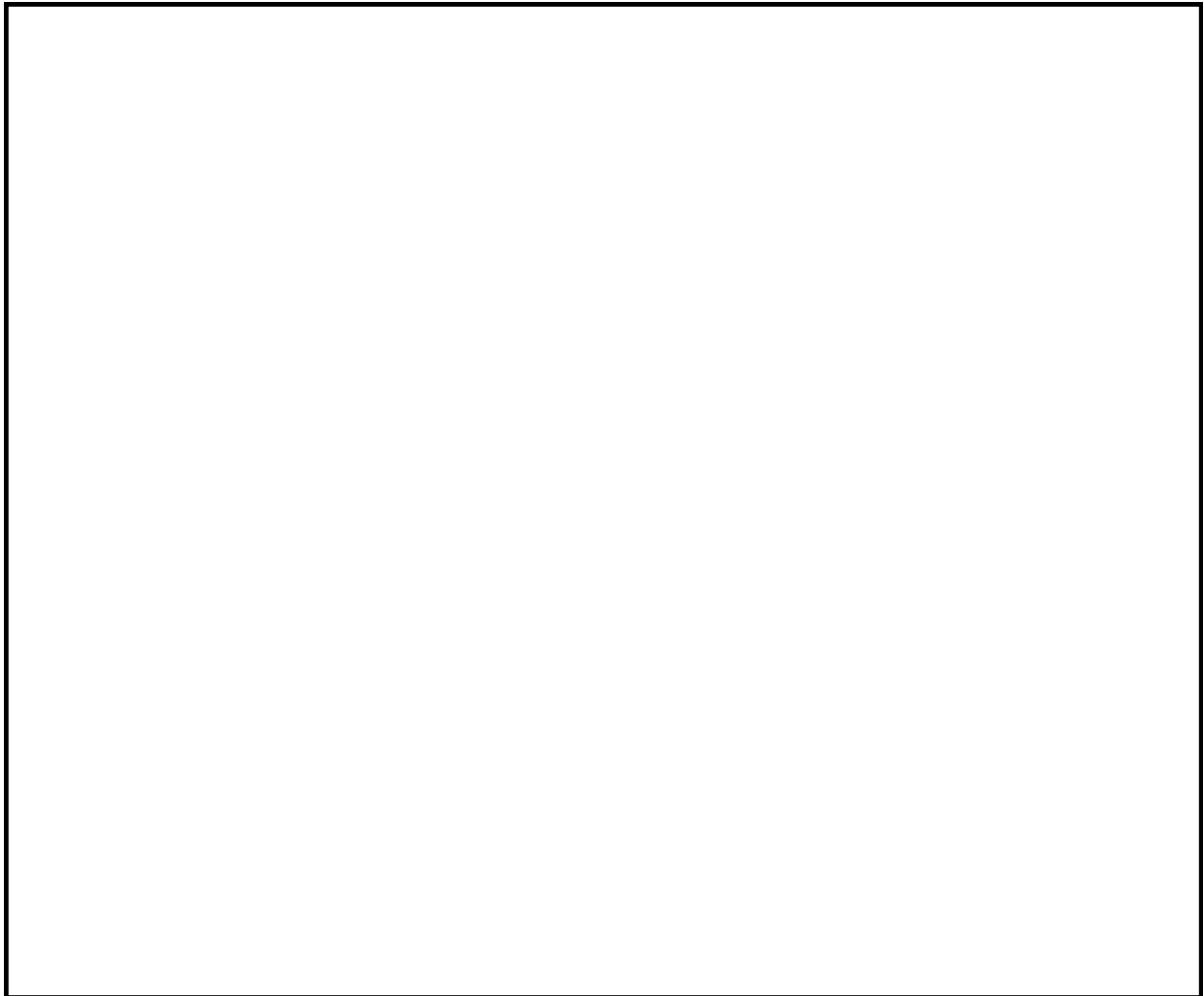


ORANGUTAN PROBLEMS

Problem #2:

An orangutan wants a nut that is trapped inside of a hard shell.

to get to the nut inside.
