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### **Concessions Report (Strickland)**

-Middle school concessions is in good shape. They had a great Winter Slam wrestling event that received numerous positive reports. High school concessions is also in good shape. We need to continue to encourage volunteer sign ups, especially for Lead positions. Managers are reviewing inventory and sales and making decisions about condensing some options.

Reeb: Concessions managers are meeting on a regular basis to review sales and ongoing needs like volunteers. Many of the sports do a great job of working concessions and taking advantage of that fundraising opportunity for their teams. If teams are not yet taking advantage, please encourage them to do so and help out not only their team, but all teams by building up the concessions sales. The money is significant. We will be reaching out to teams to continue to recruit volunteers. A request was made by Holly for a manager to push an update to all teams via SportsYou. That will be done.

### **Old Business (Reeb)**

At our November meeting, we discussed moving the sports decals sales and installation/de-install process over to the Rage Cage as a fundraising opportunity for them. Darrin met with Mrs. Stooksbury this week about both the decals as well as selling the seasonal sports programs at events. Rage Cage struggles with fundraising but needs a bank from which to do more and draw more student attendance at all events. Winter decals were picked up last week and installed by Rage Cage shortly thereafter.

Wilson: Ads for the spring program are on sale now. Please direct any interested advertisers to the BWAB website for more information and purchase.

### **New Business (All)**

BWAB has worked with Hudl representatives to secure a Focus camera for the middle school turf field, where some of the high school teams play at times. There is value in having a Hudl system at the middle school for those times as well as showcases and other larger events like the Eagle Showcase the high school soccer team sponsors. BWAB is making a request to approve a \$2,000 expenditure to install a Hudl Focus camera that can be used at the middle



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school by all sports (one year contract). Michael Colton from HS Boys Soccer reiterated the value of having a camera at the middle school for high school teams to use while there.

HS Boys Soccer went on to make a funding request for help with a uniform purchase. The coaching staff is entering Year 5. Uniforms were purchased in Year 2 and are now 3 years old and showing some wear and tear. They are close to being sustainable as a program but they do face a current shortfall of about \$4,000 to pay for the uniform order. The total cost of the uniform order is \$12,000 for both a home and away kit. This is a one-time ask; in the future, especially with the showcase and its growth, the team will have the ability to pay for every-two-year uniform replacements with no issues. The team has actively fundraised, including the showcase, has put a significant amount of work into the middle school grass field (upwards of 100 volunteers throwing dirt and grass seed, aerating, rolling, etc), hosted a dunk tank at Sizzle & Sound, has worked concessions, sponsored a youth camp alongside the HS Girls Soccer team, and supporting the burgeoning middle school soccer program.
