Re: Invitation to Development Control Committee on 22nd September 2026 @ 6:00pm

I write to inform you of the planning and related applications which are scheduled for debate at DCC meeting on 22/09/2026. If you are a Parish or Town Council for which one or more of these applications relates, you are cordially invited to address the committee at the beginning of the relevant item(s). This is an opportunity to bring to the attention of the District Councillors the views of your community. A Town or Parish representative will normally be a serving Councillor or an employee such as the Parish Clerk, but could include a planning consultant retained by the parish and speaking on your behalf.

This facility will also be given to the District Ward Councillor(s), those opposing the scheme and those supporting the application. The order of public speaking is:

- 1) Ward Member(s) 2) Parish Council 3) Opposition 4) Supporters

Other than District Councillors, the three other slots are time limited to **four** minutes. If two or more individuals want to speak in any one of the slots, say two objectors, then the time will be split equally. Unused slot will remain vacant as it is vitally important that the balance of representation is maintained. If you would like to speak, you are required to notify both democratic.services@stroud.gov.uk and planning@stroud.gov.uk by 12 noon one clear working day before the day of the meeting.
