I am writing to provide you with an update on The Knoll.

As you are aware from previous discussions, we wish to hold an event in the village hall to provide residents with the opportunity to view the proposed plans for the site and ask any questions prior to submitting a planning application.

We will be holding an Information Drop-In Event on Wednesday 30th September. Due to the anticipated number of attendees, we will have two time slots with a welfare break for officers and consultants in between. The first time slot will be between 4pm and 5pm and the second time slot between 5:30pm and 6:30pm.

The proposed plans will be available on our website prior to the event; this will enable residents to view the plans in advance of the event or if they are unable to attend. The event is intended to be an informal drop-in opportunity with display boards showing the proposals, SDC officers and consultants will be available to provide information on the scheme and discuss individual queries in more detail.

We will be writing to residents with properties accessed from South Street to invite them to attend, the letter will include links which will enable them to: indicate which slot they would like to attend, view the proposals online, or contact us if they are unable to attend and do not have access to the internet.

To ensure that all residents of Uley who are interested in the proposals have the opportunity to attend, we are also proposing to display the invitation with details of the event in the village shop in addition to sharing with the Parish Council so that you may publish this on your website. If there is anywhere else locally that you feel the information should be displayed then please let us know.

Further to residents' feedback from other schemes and recognising that the planning process provides the formal public consultation process, we have changed our pre-application public engagement to focus on keeping communities well informed and better prepared to participate in the planning consultation. This approach aims to ensure residents have up to date relevant information, in advance of the planning application submission.

As you may remember we previously provided you with estimated milestones for this site. We have been unable to hold the event prior to the summer holidays and I have updated and attached the milestones accordingly.
