
Saying goodbye to our beloved, Brenda Weems

Blessing of the Animals service will be held on Sunday, October 5th at 2:00 pm



We'll gather outside with our four-legged friends – dogs, cats, rabbits, hamsters, reptiles, etc. – and participate in the blessing service. Karla will lead us in a brief service that includes blessing each animal present. Please remember to have your dogs on a leash and your other animals safely kept in a travel crate.

Episcopal Blessing of the Animals services stem from the 13th-century life and traditions of Saint Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of animals, with the modern popularization of the practice happening significantly in the late 20th century. These services, often held around October 4th, the Feast of St. Francis, celebrate God's creation and acknowledge the important role animals play in our lives, serving as a way to express appreciation for pets and the broader natural world.

Plan to stay after church on October 19. Grab your coffee and snacks and a seat, and we'll get to hear Rebecca Gaskin share some of her experience in Abu Dubai, in the United Arab Emirates. She and Arnold have lived there for five years. They live in a multi-cultural, multi-religious, multi-ethnic community which has many opportunities to learn about each other. The Anglican Church they attend, where Rebecca is on the leadership council, manages a compound where the Anglican community shares space with multiple guest congregations, including the Syrian Orthodox Church, the Ethiopian Orthodox Church, Church of South India, a Hindu temple and others. They socialize and celebrate Ramadan and the Eid holy days, and several Indian holy days and festivals. Abu Dhabi is the capitol of the United Arab Emirates, a country that promotes religious and cultural tolerance in the Gulf. Rebecca will tell us a little about the community and the people where she and Arnold live.
