Our heart is to stand in the gap for young people, reduce youth offending, and walk with them into a future filled with hope.

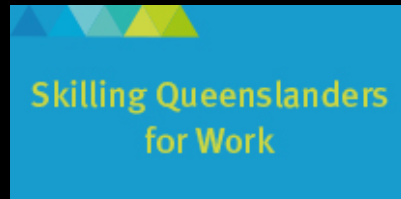


# New Horizon Project

The New Horizon Project is an **engaging 8-week program** designed specifically for youth who are disengaged from school and at **risk of involvement with QPS and Youth Justice**. This initiative offers a fresh, hands-on approach to learning, tailored to meet young people where they are. Participants will work towards **achieving a Certificate I in Construction** through practical training, while also receiving **consistent mentoring and support**. With two dedicated Youth Support Workers guiding them throughout the program, the New Horizon Project provides not just skills for work, but **pathways for a brighter future**.

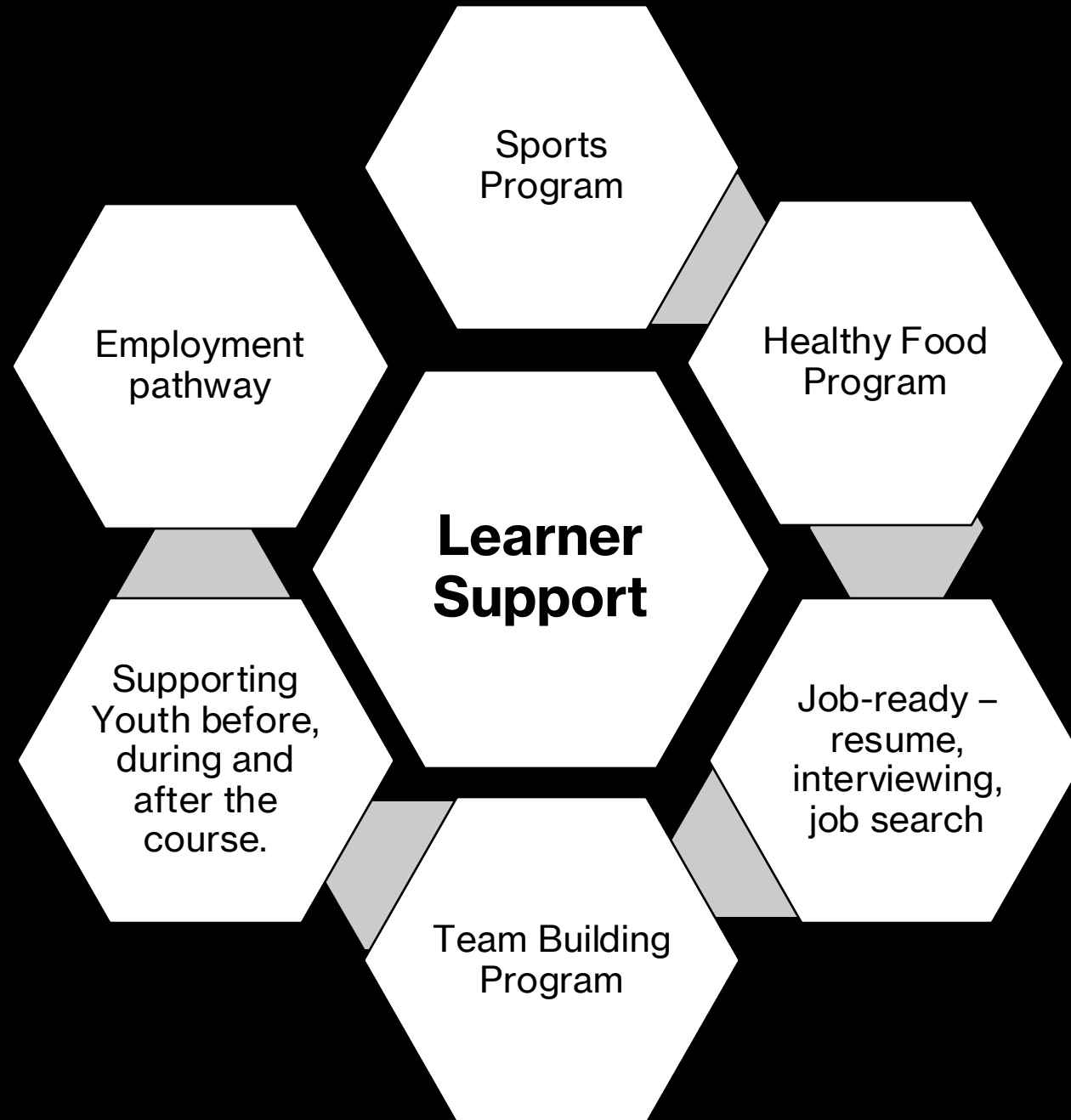
