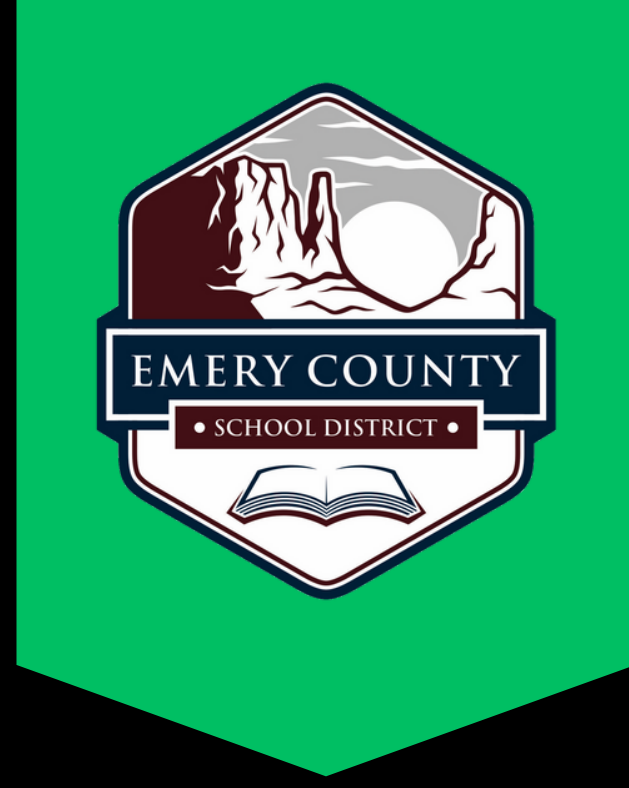

Organize committees from the components

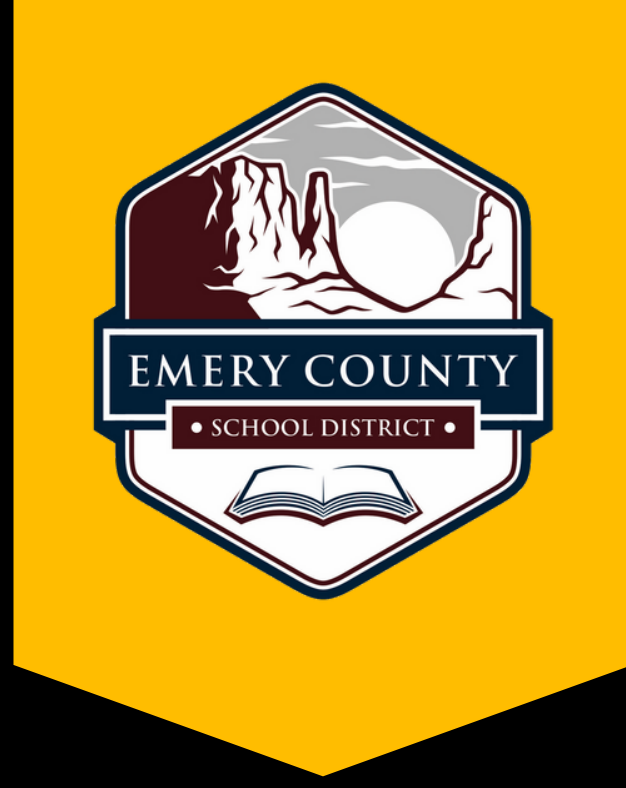
Determine committee objectives

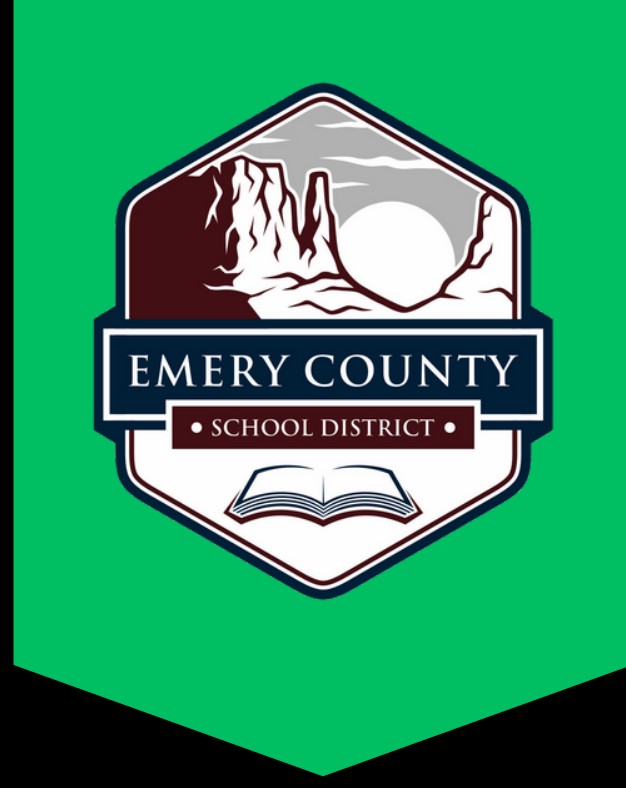

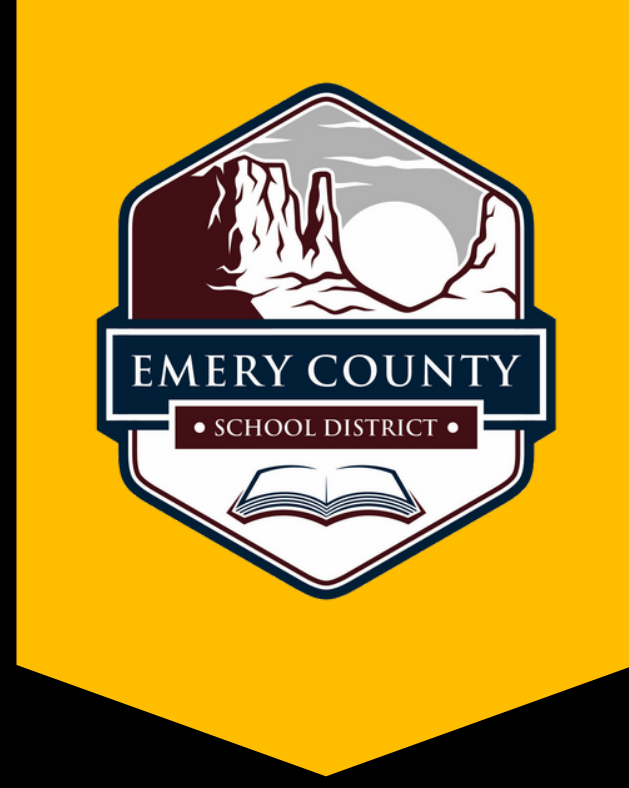
