

Dear Parent/Guardian,

This notice is to inform you that your student has engaged in **disruptive student behavior** as defined in Utah Code §53G-8-210 and District policy. Because your student is **nine years of age or older** and has met the criteria listed below, the school is required to issue this formal notice.

- Three (3) incidents during the school year that did **not** result in suspension or expulsion
- One (1) incident during the school year that **did** result in suspension or expulsion



Dear Parent/Guardian,

This notice is to inform you that your student has been identified as engaging in **habitual disruptive student behavior** as defined in Utah Code §53G-8-210. Because your student is **nine years of age or older** and has met the criteria below, the school is required to issue this formal notice.

### Criteria for Habitual Disruptive Behavior

Your student has met one or more of the following:

- Six (6) or more disruptive incidents not resulting in suspension/expulsion
- Three (3) or more disruptive incidents not resulting in suspension/expulsion **and** one (1) resulting in suspension/expulsion
- Two (2) or more disruptive incidents resulting in suspension/expulsion
