The story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego stands as a timeless testament to the power of courageous faith. These three young men faced the most terrifying of threats—a fiery furnace—because they refused to bow to a false god. Their decision wasn't just bold; it was sacrificial. They willingly gave up their comfort, safety, and even their very lives to remain faithful to the one true God.

This kind of sacrifice does not begin in a moment of crisis. It is forged over time in the quiet places of devotion, strengthened through obedience, and tested in the flames of suffering. Their response to Nebuchadnezzar's threat—"Even if He does not deliver us..." (Daniel 3:18)—is one of the clearest portraits of self-denying faith in all of Scripture.

Suffering as the Refining Fire

While God miraculously delivered them from physical harm, the significance of their trial goes far beyond their rescue. The furnace symbolizes the suffering that believers endure for righteousness' sake. Like gold refined by fire, our faith is proven genuine through hardship (1 Peter 1:7).

Praise be to the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who has sent his angel and rescued his servants! They trusted in him and defied the king's command and were willing to give up their lives rather than serve or worship any god except their own God.

I prayed with them, listened to their stories, and shared my journey as a short-term missionary nurse. Many of them were encouraged and even prayed with and for me. It reminded me that no matter what trials we face, **God is always present using every moment for His glory.**

SACRIFICE

t Easter, our first thought naturally turns to the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross, made to pay the price for our sins. He bore the full wrath of God against sin upon Himself, so that all

who place their trust in Him could be forgiven and receive eternal life. He died so that we might live — not only in this life, but for eternity.

In addition to the sacrifices commanded of the people of Israel in the Old Testament, the Bible also speaks of other forms of sacrifices.

Shall we check our own lives in the light of these?

1. From the Psalms:

Psalm 4:5 Sacrifices of righteousness, living according to God's standards. Also in Psalm 51:19

Psalm 27:6 Sacrifices of joy due to the victory over enemies. What are the enemies in our lives? Self is often the biggest one!

Psalm 51:17 The sacrifices of a broken spirit, a broken and contrite heart. This condition of heart comes when we, in acute awareness of our sinfulness, come to God in repentance, seeking His forgiveness. Written by David after his sin with Bathsheba in 2 Samuel, chapters 11 and 12. He knew He had done wrong (adultery and murder) and desperately sought - and received! - God's forgiveness.



2. Others mentioned in the Bible

Jeremiah 17:26 Sacrifices of praise. This became vividly real to me while living and working with Healthcare Christian Fellowship in Holland between 1970 and 1985. A vehicle was badly needed to travel around Europe in the interests of HCF. The Lord had miraculously provided most of the funds, but, before an important conference in another country, to which I needed to travel, the purchase could not be done on time. So the only option was public transport! A huge disappointment, especially as there were so many things we needed to take with us! At that time an older believer advised me: "Come let us praise the Lord!" It was really difficult — truly a "sacrifice of praise"!! By His grace I obeyed in spite of feelings! The result was peace and the vehicle came soon afterwards.

3. Perhaps the most important sacrifice God requires is found in Romans 12:1,2: "I beg you therefore brothers and sisters to present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good, acceptable and perfect will of God"

What must we sacrifice? Our bodies, including our minds.

Why should we do this? Because "you have been bought with a price", 1 Corinthians 7:23; we do not belong to ourselves, but to the One Who paid with His blood for us!

Is this reasonable? Yes! - because we are His. We cannot only accept His forgiveness and the new life He gives in the Spirit, without obeying His command. If we buy something, it belongs to us, and we can do with it whatever we please. No difference spiritually. We belong to Him, body, soul and spirit.

What will be the result? We won't be conformed

ENDURING FOR MY GOD

"Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." — Matthew 11:29 (NKJV)—

he verse above is a beautiful reminder that even in suffering or burden, Christ offers rest—not through escape, but through walking closely with Him in humility and trust.

For over 35 years, I have lived with the unrelenting burden of sinus nasal congestion, diagnosed as vasomotor rhinitis—a condition that took hold before 1990 and has never truly let go. Now, at 83, I still grapple daily with its wide-reaching effects.

Over time, the illness progressed to include vasomotor gastric rhinitis, creating a constant cycle of nose blowing and mouth breathing. This has dulled my sense of taste so profoundly that only the most basic flavors—sweet, sour, bitter, and tart—remain detectable. The symptoms intensify not only after eating or drinking but even on an empty stomach, turning everyday moments into ongoing struggles.

"I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us." — Romans 8:18 (NIV) —

In 1991, after nearly a year of intermittent antibiotic treatments in six-week cycles, I underwent sinus surgery. It offered brief relief—but the symptoms soon returned, fiercer than before.

Through it all, my faith has remained steadfast. I continue to trust in God for guidance, comfort, and healing. Decades of discomfort and disappointment have tested me, yet it is my belief in divine strength that sustains me—especially in the face of medical answers that, at best, have provided only temporary relief.

GOD'S MIRACULOUS INTERVENTION

s a young girl raised in Arizona, I recall attending church weekly with my parents and my grand-mother (since grandma didn't drive, we drove her every Sunday.) It was then that my Biblical foundation and Christian faith were laid with a strong belief in almighty God, for which I'm eternally grateful. My faith journey has carried me through life's challenges over the years, as our sovereign God has showed up in miraculous ways with supernatural protection, and healing. The Bible tells us that "our Lord is the same yesterday, today and forever." - Hebrews 13:8.

My life has been a living testimony of His **timeless** miracles.

My senior year of high school, I was snow skiing with our church youth group in New Mexico, where I fell on moguls and broke my leg. Thankfully, I was surrounded by friends praying over me the entire drive home from New Mexico to Arizona, declaring complete healing over my leg. Once we arrived home, my Mother took me to an orthopedic doctor where he did an X-ray and astonishingly exclaimed a "Miraculous" alignment of my fibula bone, as he showed us the proof on the X-ray. I recall how surprised the doctor looked when he saw the broken bone had already re-aligned perfectly, which meant he didn't have to set it himself. I simply thought to myself, well of course it's fine, because we prayed & God, (our Ultimate Physician), heard our prayers and healed it! That was the beginning of my child-like simplistic faith, with medical proof. "The prayers of a righteous person are powerful and effective", James 5:16

My trusting in God's faithfulness & healing continued as I faced the medical diagnosis of thyroid cancer many years later. Following a needle biopsy on my thyroid gland, the endocrinologist informed me that I needed immediate surgery to remove a cancerous goiter. At that time, I had my small group from church in northern California praying for my health and healing prior to the surgery. I was trusting God and recall praying my favorite life verse from Proverbs 3:5-6, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him and He shall direct your paths." Then following the surgery, the pathology report miraculously revealed that it was benign, so NO cancer!

Praise the LORD, as I knew the only explanation was answered prayers, in the mighty name of Jesus. I've learned that the authority of His name is the key to unlocking God's miraculous intervention.

I once again experienced (and personally witnessed) the redeeming power of God when I was pregnant with my first-born son. I was deemed a highrisk pregnancy and my OB-GYN doctor put me on complete bedrest for six weeks, due to seriously early complications. Later, my full-term pregnancy clearly revealed another medical miracle, when delivering the baby. My husband, Bob, was in the delivery room with me and we will never forget the moment when the doctor claimed our baby was an "absolute miracle" who hung on by just 5%!! She physically handed my husband evidence in the placenta where you could visibly see how the placenta had bled out and was discolored and scarred by 95%, which meant that the baby had hung on by only 5%, ...so she called our son, the "5% miracle baby!!". We praised God and thanked HIM for hearing our cries and answering our prayers. "The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles."- Psalm 34:17.

Thus, I encourage you to call upon the Lord and wait expectantly for your miracle. Give thanks to Him in advance for what He will do, when you seek Him with all your heart.

IMPACT ETHIOPIA MINISTRIES (IEM)

ark and Krista Haley work with Impact Ethiopia Ministries (IEM) and have been making an impact for almost ten years in Ethiopia. While planting churches is their focus, they are spreading the Gospel and transforming lives in Ethiopia through what God is doing with their unique mission built on the foundation of **MEDS**:

Medical Care: Bringing healing and hope to the underserved.

Empowering Leaders: Training and equipping leaders for sustainable change.

Discipleship: Raising up Christ-centered communities.

Small Groups: Building deep, personal connections through faith.



Krista uses her God-given talents as a nurse to help Ethiopians who struggle to get the basic medical education and care they need. Whether she is training mothers how to take care of their child's wounds, teaching people proper nutrition, or getting someone the medical help they need, it opens the door for people to hear the Gospel and connect to a church plant. She also has a passion for women's ministry, which helps to encourage and grow women in the Lord. In 2024 alone, she led four different conferences for over 180 women and gave them new hope and strength in the Lord.

Mark empowers national church planters and leaders to make an impact in their communities. He trains new church planters to go into new areas and plant churches in unreached parts of Ethiopia. Over the last year, he has trained and sent out ten new church planters. He also helps to train existing church pastors and leaders to give them the tools they need. Most of our church



planters do not have the chance to go to seminary or receive formal training in any way, so we can come alongside them and provide some biblical training that they need to lead others. In 2024, Mark led four trainings in different parts of Ethiopia for pastors and church leaders.

Over the last four years, IEM has planted 22 new church plants in unreached areas, bringing hope and life to hundreds of individuals. Animist communities have been transformed as people have come to know the one true God and serve Him, putting down their idols and witchcraft. The church planters come back from different areas, telling stories about how God has healed the blind and sick, leading many people to Christ. Many demons are being cast out of people, and their lives are being restored. Other people see these things happening and believe in the power of the almighty God and Jesus Christ, who is being professed.

Krista invests in ladies' and children's ministry and uses her nursing background to meet basic physical needs as well as implement CHE (Community Health Evangelism) in the villages to open doors which allows them to share about the love of Jesus.

Suffering, when tied to godly sacrifice, becomes a powerful vehicle for spiritual transformation. It strips away superficial comforts, exposes the depth of our convictions, and reveals the presence of Christ walking with us—just as a fourth figure appeared with the men in the furnace.

God may not always remove the fire, but He always joins us in it. He sanctifies suffering, using it to deepen our reliance on Him and to shape us more fully into His image.

The Witness of Sacrificial Faith

Daniel 3:28 captures the result of faithful suffering: witness and worship. The very king who ordered their execution becomes a herald of God's glory. This is the paradox of sacrificial suffering—it looks like defeat but leads to spiritual victory. When believers choose obedience over comfort, and integrity over survival, the watching world takes notice.

True sacrifice costs something, and suffering is often the currency of lasting impact. But from the ashes of hardship, a powerful testimony arises—one that can soften hearts, change kingdoms, and turn the hearts of rulers toward God.

The Call to Costly Obedience

In today's world, the flames may not be literal, but the pressure to conform is just as real. Sacrificing popularity, opportunities, or even relationships for the sake of Christ remains a daily reality for many. Yet the promise of Daniel 3 holds firm: God is with us in the fire.

Our calling is not to avoid suffering, but to face it with the confidence that even if God does not deliver us in the way we expect, our sacrifice is not in vain. Faithfulness in the furnace glorifies God, refines our souls, and declares to the world that there is no other God who saves like ours.

to this world. It's passing pleasures and temptations, won't be attractive any longer.

How does this happen? By having our minds renewed. Thinking Biblically.

For what purpose? To prove/experience that God's will is good, acceptable and perfect! If we want to live a life which is truly Christlike and pleasing to our Heavenly Father, we cannot hold onto our bodies! We need to remember that "Without Holiness no one will see the Lord", Hebrews 12:14. Sanctification is an essential, ongoing process until we die. He will, by His indwelling Spirit, control (with our co-operation) our thoughts, attitudes, behavior, manners, plans, motivations, the use of our time, money etc. ALL belongs to Him and to Him alone! No longer to us! I cannot say "Mine" about anything!

This will affect every area of our lives. Even when facing persecution and suffering, we can say, with Jesus: "Not My will, but Yours be done", Mark 14:36. This is the only way to live a life of peace, fulfilment, fruitfulness, joy and the enjoyment of the presence of our Father God without a guilty conscience. What a prospect! even this side of eternity! I can testify, after 50 years of seeking to be obedient to this command, that Father's will is always "good, perfect and acceptable"!

Who is ready and willing for this sacrifice in obedience to God's Word? No matter how hard it may seem, there will never be any regrets! The opposite will be, to get to the end of life, face the judgement of God, and have to say "If only I had....." Then it will be too late!!

Leonora was born in George, South Africa on 24th of January 1941. She moved to Bloemfontein when her parents divorced. She was brought up, with great sacrifice, by her mother. She came to know Jesus as her Savior at 14 years of age. After completing school, she trained as a nurse and midwife. And in 1966 she joined HCF as a full-time staff worker.

From mid 1970 Leonora was based in the Netherlands as the Regional Promoter for HCFI in Western Europe. She established a training center for HCFI in Voorthuizen, Holland. Trainees came from all over the world and a number of them are currently still involved full-time with HCFI including the HCFI President, Dr. Chris Steyn and Dr. Arul Anketell, who is on the International Board. From 1986 to 2016, she served as the Regional Promoter of HCFI in South East Asia also including visits to a number of other countries. In 2016, after 50 years in HCF full-time work, and according to guidance from the Lord, she stepped down from HCFI work and now living in her birth town, George, in the Western Cape, South Africa.



Israeli-Arab conflict in the Holy Land moved to a new level over a century ago, intensifying since 1948. The conflict that escalated in October 2023 saw horrific attacks against civilians in Israel. Israel responded by invading Gaza, and the death and destruction that followed was orders of magnitude worse. The conflict led to waves of global marches, protests, and counterprotests with a divided world arguing about who to blame. The destruction of Gaza has wrought devastation, drawing accusations of genocide, while failing to eliminate Hamas – the basis for the invasion. Resolution



to any conflict is elusive due to competing claims and agendas. Both sides lay claim to the land, and all human efforts to resolve this conflict have failed. As long as corrupt evil men who desire violence control both governments, and while hatred is harbored in people's hearts, no ceasefire can last long. Cry out for God's mercy, and pray that both sides of this conflict will find true reconciliation and genuine Shalom through Jesus the Messiah.

WHAT IS HCF?

he Healthcare Christian Fellowship (HCF) is a non-profit interdenominational organization among caregivers.

In 1936, Francis Grim, a Christian businessman in South Africa, and his brother, Carl, visited their elderly father daily in a local hospital. During these visits they noticed that the patient's physical needs were well taken care of, but their spiritual needs were largely ignored.

Francis was alarmed and concerned about the lack of spiritual care. He realized that many patients pass through the healthcare systems of our world who do not pass through our churches.

Yet, when they are ill, they often want to reach out to God: A God they do not know. They need someone to teach them the Good News of Jesus' forgiveness, care, healing, joy and salvation.

He began to train a small group of student nurses how to share their faith with their patients and fellow workers. This was the beginning of what has now become Healthcare Christian Fellowship International (HCFI), a world-wide movement among all branches of healthcare, active in over 100 countries around the world. Doctrinal Basis

The Doctrinal Basis of HCFI shall consist of the essential beliefs of Biblical Christianity, including:

- The unity of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit in the Godhead.
- The person of our Lord Jesus Christ as very God and very Man, born of the virgin Mary, His real and sinless humanity, His atoning death, His bodily resurrection, and His ascension into Heaven.
- The Divine inspiration and supreme authority of the Holy Scripture in all matters of faith and conduct.
- The guilt and depravity of human nature in consequence of the Fall.
- The substitutionary death of our Lord Jesus Christ, and His resurrection, as the only way of salvation from sin through repentance and faith.
- The necessity for the new birth by the Holy Spirit and His indwelling in the believer for sanctification and service.
- The personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ and the judgment to come for the just and for the unjust.

- The resurrection of the body and eternal life.
- Hell as a place of eternal punishment for all who rejected the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Heaven as a place of everlasting blessedness for all who have accepted the Lord Jesus Christ.

In brief, HCFI places a strong emphasis upon the Deity of Jesus Christ and His Atonement; regeneration by the Holy Spirit and His indwelling fullness in the believer for personal victory and fruitfulness; the supreme authority of the Scriptures and the importance of personal and group evangelism.
