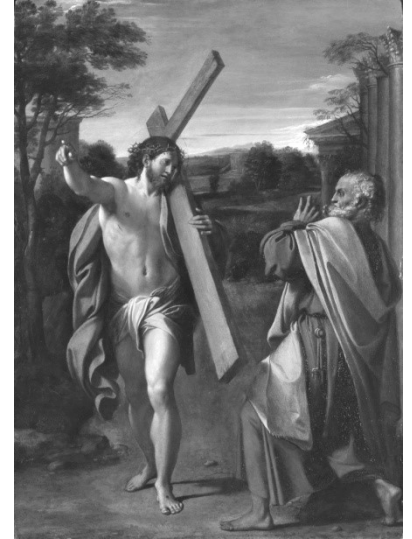

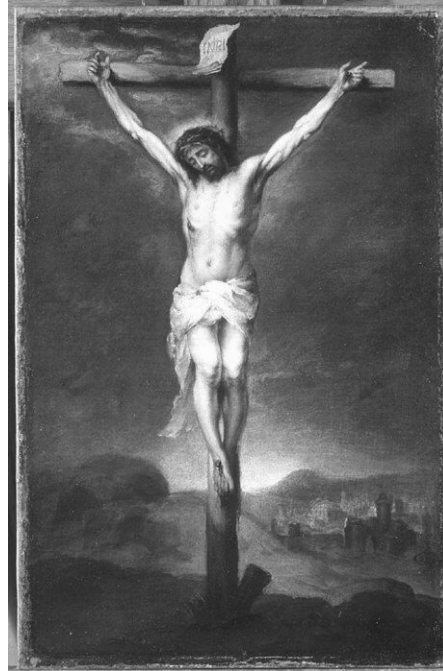
Mass/Confession Schedule – There will be no daily Mass, Saturday evening Mass, or confessions this week, Tuesday, September 1, through Saturday, September 5.
