This is the direction that MIL must move to ensure that membership of the company is enhanced and the value that MIL adds to our properties is recognised.

Based on my experience, I wish to offer my skills and knowledge to guide MIL at this critical time to ensure that opportunities are capitalised upon, while threats to the company are minimised. I believe that MIL needs to be set up for the coming decades, through careful financial management, clear direction from the Board and strong water policy.
