Revised Schedule of Charges 2025-26

Update to Annexure A for the Water Administration Ministerial Corporation Rural Bulk Water price

IPART has now determined the maximum prices the NSW Government (WAMC) can charge customers for its water planning, management, and regulation services ([Prices for Water Administration Ministerial Corporation \(WAMC\) from 1 October 2025 | IPART](#)). These services are separate to those provided by WaterNSW.

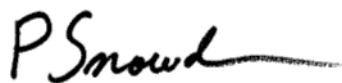
IPART has limited WAMC to an average price increase of 5% per year, plus inflation. This will result in a total increase of 21.6% - plus inflation - for the period these prices will apply, which is from 1 October 2025 to 30 June 2029.

Following the release of the IPART final decision, WaterNSW has published its Rural Bulk Water prices for period 1 October 2025 to 30 June 2026, and Murray Irrigation has subsequently included these charges in the attached updated Annexure A. These charges are passed on by Murray Irrigation to our customers and must be listed accordingly in our Schedule of Charges. The charges are identified as “government pass through charges” and are charged against Water Entitlements and water usage. The Schedule of Charges is effective from 1 October 2025. 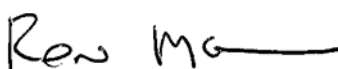
