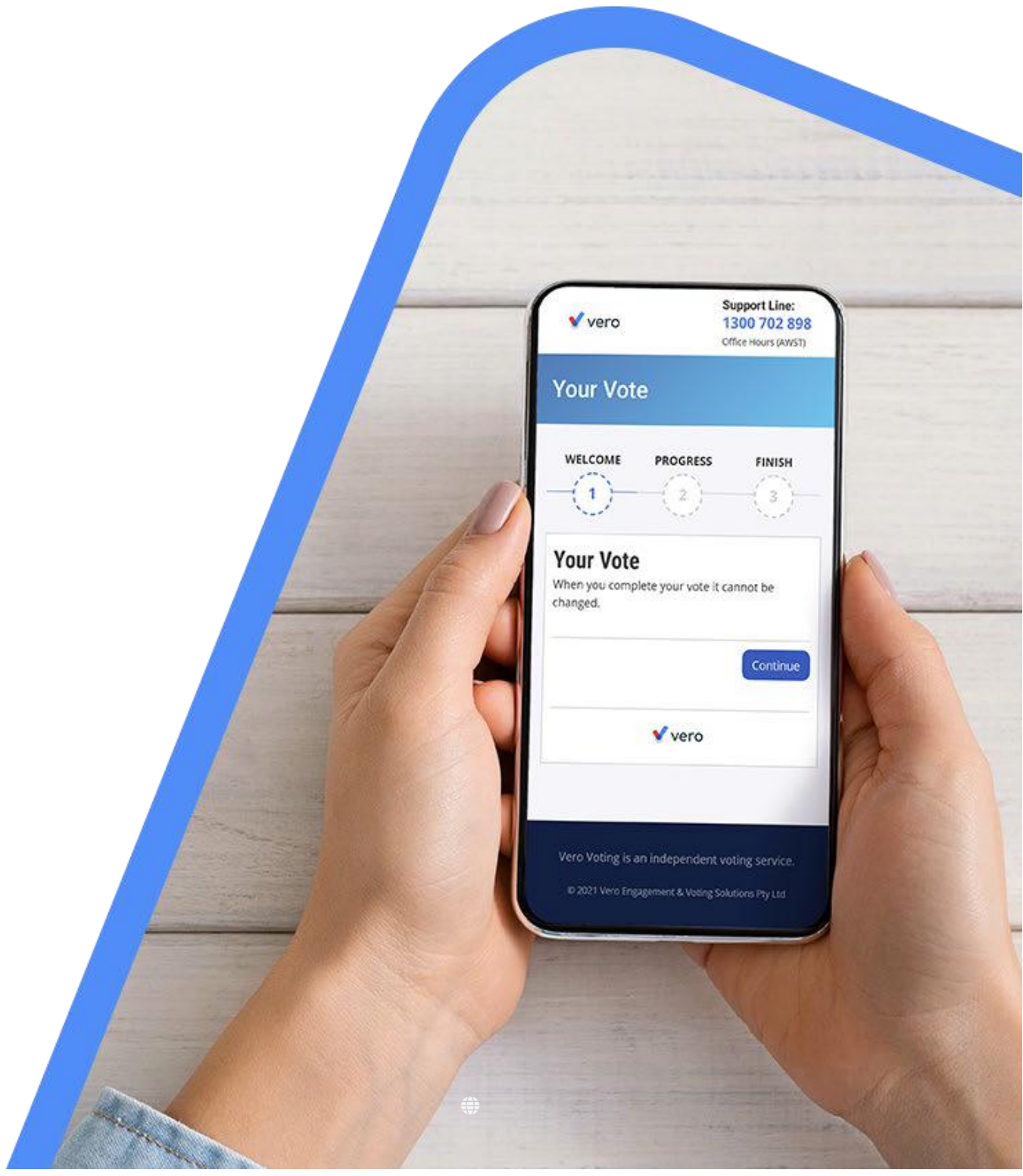


HOW TO VOTE

Voting Information for: Murray Irrigation Limited 2025 Member Director Election

Voting Information

- Vero Voting provides independent voting services.
- You can only vote once. Once you have voted, you cannot vote again.
- The Declaration of Result will be sent to Murray Irrigation Limited (MIL). This is a report with only vote results, no individual results will be revealed.
- You will be provided with voting information via either email or post by Vero Voting with the following:
 - Unique URL Link
 - Username: 7-digit number
 - Password: 4-digit pin

STEP 1 – LOGIN

You will receive login credentials from Vero Voting via either post or email. Follow these instructions to login.

If via email, simply click the link in your email and it will log you in to the online voting system.

If via postal, enter the URL: <https://mil.verovoting.com.au> enter the Username and PIN supplied in the letter.

Please Note that if you are not financial at 5pm Thursday 28 August 2025, you will not be eligible to vote.


STEP 3 – Voting

CLICK in the boxes next to the name of the candidate and it will put a NUMBER next to the name in order of your clicks. If you make a mistake, click RESET to start again. You do not need to vote for all four candidates. Your vote will be valid even if you only vote for one candidate. Please refer to the 'Optional Preferential Voting' guide for additional information.

Click the candidate to put a "1", "2", "3", "4" on them in order of your preference.

If you've made a mistake and would like to change the order of your vote, please select the reset button at the bottom of the ballot.

Vero Voting is a completely anonymous and confidential voting service. We are not affiliated with MIL and have been simply commissioned to facilitate this Election. Please cast your personal vote however you wish. It is completely up to you.

Frequently Asked Questions

Who is Vero Voting?

Vero Voting is an independent Australian company that specialises in planning, management and delivery of independent elections. We have worked with small and large companies such as the Reserve Bank of Australia, Bendigo Bank and KPMG.

Why has Vero Voting contacted me?

If you have been contacted by Vero Voting with voting information, it is because you are listed on the voters list of an election that Vero Voting is managing.

How did Vero Voting get my details?

Vero Voting asks for a voters list from our clients for each election. This voters list will contain details of each eligible voter. We use the voters list to manage access to our voting system, and to contact you with voting information.

Will Vero Voting contact me in the future?

Once an election is over all personal details are deleted in line with our internal security policy. The only way you will be contacted from Vero Voting is if you are on the voters list for an election in the future, in which case your details would be provided to us at that time.

Does anyone know how I voted?

No. We only conduct secret elections. Every election created in our system is anonymous. Your personal information enables authentication and is not associated with your vote preference.

I can't find my login details to access the vote.

Voting instructions and login details are sent directly by Vero Voting. If you have received an email, SMS, or Letter from Vero Voting, please check it for your login details. If you have misplaced this information, please ring the support line on 1300 702 898.

The voting webpage isn't working

Please use an alternative web browser if your current browser is not working. Google Chrome is the preferred web browser to use. If you are still having difficulty accessing the vote online, please ring the support line on 1300 702 898.

Can I vote more than once?

No.

Have I voted?

When you have conducted your vote, Vero voting will send you a receipt either via email or SMS.

When do I receive the results of the vote?

Vero Voting will send the Declaration of Results to the client once the vote has closed. It will be up to the client when and how this information will be released.

Can I vote early?

Only votes lodged during the voting period will be counted. This means that you cannot vote before or after the voting period.
