RESOLUTION No. 1491

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR EXCAVATION TO CONSTRUCT A WATER MAIN ALONG ORCHARD DRIVE FOR THE VILLAGE OF LEIPSIC.

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio has agreed to use Community Development Block Grant Funds allocated by the Putnam County Commissioners for purchasing materials necessary to construct the Orchard Drive Water Main Project; and

WHEREAS, It is necessary for the Village of Leipsic to finance the excavation and furnish the labor to install the water main; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic to be in the best of interest of the Community to construct the Orchard Drive Water Main since it allows for looping of existing water mains within the Village and will be a supply line for needed water services of the Northwest Retirement Ministeries of Otterbein Homes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Village Administrator is authorized to advertise for bids for a backhoe to do the excavation necessary to install the water main.

Section 2. The Village Administrator is authorized to accept the lowest and best bid and to sign all documents necessary for the completion of a contract.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
