A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BIDS FOR THE MATERIALS TO CONSTRUCT THE ORCHARD DRIVE WATER MAIN LOOP.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio has agreed to use Community Development Block grant Funds allocated by the Putnam County Commissioners for purchasing materials necessary to construct the Orchard Drive Water Main Project; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Putnam County, Ohio, have advertised, received, and opened bids for the purchase of materials for the Orchard Drive Water Main Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Leipsic has allocated funds for their share of the construction of the said Water Main; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the Village of Leipsic to be in the best of interest of the Community to construct the Orchard Drive Water Main, since it allows for looping of existing water mains within the Village and will be a supply line for needed water services of the Northwest Retirement Ministries of Otterbein Homes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Leipsic, Putnam County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Village Administrator be instructed to inform the Putnam County Commissioners to accept the bid of \$15,238.02 from Perrysburg Pipe Company for the materials needed for the Orchard Drive Water Main.

Section 2. The Village Administrator shall also inform the Putnam County Commissioners that the Village of Leipsic has allocated the funds for their share of the cost of construction of the Orchard Drive Water Main, estimated at \$5,500.00 for excavation and \$14,000.00 for labor and materials.

This Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
